Secretary (Julie)

- Email contact list has grown steadily as we've started sending emails, fundraising and using the other features of Membership Toolkit. Suggest figuring out ways to engage parents on the site at the very beginning of the year next year.
- Gave an overview of the Dartmouth Meet & Greet, Oster probably had about 25 kids attend and total there were about 100 kids, Guadalupe had the highest attendance as they organized. Next year we should engage earlier and get the word out much earlier – this year we didn't know until right before or during spring break and the event was the day before the 5th graders went to Science Camp.

- International Night Recap Eva/Penny Nicole spoke on behalf of Eva and Penny who couldn't attend.
 - They were really pleased 14 countries represented, 4 groups performed, met minimum on food trucks, kids enjoyed passports and scavenger hunt.
 - The event came in under budget.
 - Suggest continuing as an every other year event.

 When asked why not every year, Nicole noted that she had heard that it had become very competitive and the pause helps. Plus it's hard to fit into the spring schedule. Penny will still be at Oster 2 years from now, will hopefully lead again.

• Walk A Thon Recap - Nicole/ Sara. Nicole reported out.

- Tried really hard to bring back to what it used to be, it was a learning year and they have notes on how to make it run more smoothly next year
- Kids did amazing at bringing in sponsors, Vibhor set up the fundraising on Membership
 Toolkit and it was great
- Ice cream party winning classes on average, 19 students per class 4 way tie but going by %. Sheik, Growitz and Burrill will have ice cream parties because they had the highest % participation. Because Mr. T's class has more kids so a lower percentage, they will, will get frozen Friday cards.
- The 3 students who raised the most individually will get Amazon cards.
- In terms of expenses, most spent on t-shirts. It was really great to see all the kids in their shirts, they loved them and if we had to cut costs next year, we could decide not to do them.
- Want to continue annually, could move to the fall and get in to yearbook or leave after spring break and then it won't make the yearbook deadline.
- Very pleased with the results

Enrichment / Field Trip Liaison Feedback - Amy / Julie P. – Julie P. reported out:

- All 26 classes signed up for at least 1 enrichment class and with the remaining funds some doing more than one.
- Rebecca, grateful for Amy and Julie stepping in to make this all happen to use the
 unused Starting Arts budget given that this started so late into the year, it has been
 really well organized and successful, created great enrichment experiences for students.
- Next year, we hope to have starting arts music program
