

Health Requirements Reminder

The Illinois School Code requires that students be up-to-date on their immunizations and have a current physical examination on file. We appreciate your cooperation with these requirements. Below is a breakdown of requirements per grade level.. **The Medical Exclusion Date from school is October 15th.** All requirements must be submitted by then or your child(ren) will not be allowed to attend school after that date until we have the

Pre-K (these get submitted to the ROE)

- Up-to-date on all infant immunizations
- Physical Exam
- Lead Screening

Kindergarten

- Up-to-date on all immunizations (DTP/DTaP, Polio, MMR, Hepatitis B, Varicella)
- Physical Exam
- Lead Screening
- Dental Exam
- Eye Exam

2nd Grade

- Dental Exam

6th Grade

- Physical Exam
- Up-to-date on all immunizations (Minimum of one dose of Tdap and one dose of Meningococcal)
- Dental Exam

9th Grade

- Physical Exam
- Dental Exam

12th Grade

- Up-to-date on all immunizations (Minimum of 2nd of Meningococcal)

Students Transferring into District (or entering school in Illinois for the first time)

- All requirements MUST be provided within the 30 days of the first day of attendance.
- Physical Exam
- Up-to-date on all immunizations
- Eye Exam

Other Information on Requirements:

- **Physical Exams** must be completed within one year prior to the first day of school starting. The exam must be completed on the required "Certificate of Child Health" form. Parent signature and completion of Health History section is required on this form.
- Any student who participates in school sports must turn in a **Sports Physical and Concussion Form** prior to the first practice. Students will not be allowed to participate in practice or games until these forms are turned in.
- **IESA/IHSA sports physical forms MAY NOT be used as the required school physical. However, a physical exam completed on the "Certificate of Child Health" form may be used as a sports physical.**
- Parents having questions about physical and immunization requirements should check with their family physician.
- **Dental exams must be submitted by May 15** of the current school year and must be completed no more than 18 months prior to the May 15 deadline. Dental exams must be recorded on the appropriate State of Illinois, Illinois Department of Public Health, Proof of School Dental Examination form.
