The Concept and Its 4 Pillars



This can help to ensure that resources are used in a more sustainable and equitable manner, which is essential for creating a post-scarcity world for all.

III. Trust-based system: By placing a strong emphasis on trust, cooperation, and community, a satisfaction-based economy can help to create a more equitable and sustainable economic system that benefits everyone, regardless of their economic status. Transactions will shift from "business to consumers" to "community to individuals" and "individuals to community".

IV.
