

HSSC Schedule Information

- 11th and 12th grade students will attend a double-block class at HSSC every day during either the first or second semester. (A select few courses would meet for a single block all year to allow for teacher planning time.) 9th and 10th grade students will attend a single-block class at HSSC every day during either first semester or second semester. The remaining courses for all student schedules will be held at Hanover HS. Students and families will work with school counselors to select these courses.
- Non-Health Science Specialty Center students who are traveling from AHS, PHHS, and HCPS High School to a Specialty Center elective will attend two-blocks at their home high school and two-blocks at Hanover High School during the semester of their Specialty Center elective course.
- Students in the HSSC should not be removed from the program this year if they choose the online virtual school.
 - If students return to face-to-face instruction at the start of 2nd semester, these students may be able to take the HSSC course(s) then if slots remain. This would not be available for all courses since some only have one section.
 - If students remain virtual for the entire year, these students could potentially “double-up” on HSSC courses the following school year.

Virtual School Students:

Students who choose to enroll in the virtual school setting will be provided the opportunity to attend their double-block HSSC class or their double-block Specialty Center elective in person at Hanover HS. Students would not be able to take these classes from home in the virtual setting. Students/families who are enrolled in virtual school are responsible for providing their own transportation to HSSC/HHS for their course. For HSSC students, this option would be limited to the double-block courses for juniors and seniors.

Transportation:

For HSSC students living outside of the Hanover HS zone, the school division is planning on providing bus transportation through “hub stops.” (The times and locations will be provided by transportation at a later date.) The school division is planning on providing shuttle bus transportation from each school to Hanover HS for Specialty Center electives for students who are attending school in the face-to-face format. Students will also be provided with the opportunity to drive to HHS for these courses.
