2. Review of DSSNI data model proposal (#89)
 - Discussion of how the PCORnet CDM fits with our work is on the agenda of the PI meeting this weekend, where we'll be represented by Russ.
 - Meanwhile, feedback on the draft itself: PCORnet Common Data Model v1 0 DRAFT from Campbell Mar 23
 - JimC: The use case for enrollments is a little confusing;
 - Dan: enrollment periods aren't present for hospitals;
 - Aaron: The enrollment periods don't limit the other data entered into the model; there's a lot of information that we include in VDW/Mini-sentinel that do not include the enrollment periods. This allows you to determine if someone was seen in the system and did not have a condition--or where they not seen?
 - Dan: As far as I know, we can't generate any records in that format. Nothing provides confirmation that someone was not seen.
 - Dan: Proposed comment - Is it OK if tertiary care facilities produce no enrollment periods?
 - Message from Jeffrey R Curtis, point 3 -
 - **Jim: Will use this discussion and points drafted on Sunday to prepare a response.**
 - TomM: Should we ask about de-identification?
 - Dan: No. If there's new information, we can reconsider it (#26).
3. Update from DSSNI on PopMedNet
 - Jim: Jeff Brown provided the vision for the PopMedNet clearinghouse concept. Expectation that the core data model is one that will be available/queryable. Could have multiple views/models.
4. GPC De-Identification Plan (#73)
 - any advice from dataprivacy@pcornet.org on our March 10 draft yet?
 - NathanW/Tom: No official word that the DataPrivacy group has accepted this yet. Umberto is sending Tom to those meetings. I can bring it to the next meeting.
