Overview:

Working with the Technical Director and Production Manager, our Technical Theater Interns provide support for technical theater projects related to our community theater program and our various youth theater programs. This position is not a paid internship.

We are seeking two (2) highly motivated interns with strong writing skills, teamwork ethic, creative skills, and a desire to improve their community. The following responsibilities will be shared across the two interns based on their interests.

Major Responsibilities:

- Assisting with acquiring, altering, sorting, labeling, and building costumes for three (3) fall youth shows.
- Running the lightboard for our fall Thespians production (TBD) and for our adult community theater production of Into the Woods.
- Assistant stage managing our adult community theater production of The Sound of Music.
- Provide classroom support for our Stagecraft after-school class.

Other Responsibilities:

- Maintaining a clean and tidy backstage area.
- Maintaining an accurate inventory of costumes, props, and set pieces.
- Classroom, lobby, and theater set-up and clean-up for events and classes.
- Other duties as assigned.
