GENERAL LEGEND

nsfw = Nudity and/or adult situation

nsfw-ish = Impending adult situation, suggestive nudity

sfw-ish = mostly safe, but implied pending adult stuff, or anatomically correct bumps. :P

sfw = hopefully won't damage anyone's brains if they see it on your screen

m = male

f = female

f-h = mostly female hermaphrodite

m-h = mostly male hermaphrodite

h = hermaphrodite (50/50 for m/f)

tm = transgender/inter-sexed, identifies as male

tf = transgender/inter-sexed, identifies as female

gn/u = gender neutral or gender unknown

macro = super-sized characters involved

micro = tiny sized characters involved

reference = character reference sheet

paws-only. = Paws Only; IE, the image is just footpaws/feet

foot-worship = picture denoting worship/love of feet or paws via sniffing, licking, nuzzling, etc.

foot-presentation = picture where the character is purposely showing of their feet to the viewer

foot-tease = similar to above, but where it's more of a playful/purposeful tease at the viewer

TCO! = Tame Comments Only (don't post suggestive or sexual comments on artists page; they don't want/like it)

Light-BDSM = Light bondage type play picture such as basic restraints or shibari

BDSM = more intense bondage, discipline, control, dominance, etc.

human = picture showing a human - in red to stand out for those who don't like human pics!

DETAIL! There is lots of it. O_o Rooc did an amazing job of rendering this one in pretty much every regard. The beautiful blue dragoness is enjoying the amazing soles of a very special Khajiit lady here, and you can see she is just completely into the moment - loving those feet (as much as who is attached to them). You can tell the pads are wonderfully soft with Rooc's great line work and how they flex and move at Sera's touch, and proportions... oi... those are just picture-perfect toe size, taper and pose. The expression is really well done too because it's easy to see how much the moment means to Sera. I like that it's a close up too - focuses just on the footpaws and that incredible moment of being lost in the enjoyment of a beautiful pair.

Personal Summary:

I have only recently started doing serious artwork after 10 years of going dormant, but even before then, I never really did that much drawing, at least not at my current level of detail. I can't really explain why I had this sudden drive to start drawing again, but it is most welcome! So far I have only ever drawn charr because they are by far my favorite race ever created (Thanks for Guild Wars 2, Arenanet!) and would certainly love to draw more of them in the foreseeable future. I hope that my drive continues to go strong for many years to come, with the help of others continuing to support me with motivational comments and suggestions.

Comments are a huge motivation for me to keep working on more, hence why I ask for them in every description. I always welcome tame comments of either praise or constructive criticism. People who leave creepy, suggestive, or rude comments get removed and permanently blocked from ever commenting again.

Some Q&A:

(TC) *grins and hugs the little blue dragon tight* Mmmf! Hi Sera. ^_^ Welcome (back) to the Paw-Post. So this time you're in the Artist's chair! Does it feel odd to be back as a highlight for that too?

(Sera) hello! It definitely feels different, considering in the past I never even thought to be doing what I am now, but I do enjoy it!

(TC) And that's the thing that really is so unique about this - you drew a bit in the past, but it was dormant for so long, then you picked it up again, and just.... killed it. So.... was there a trigger for this? Like why after SO long did you pick it up again?

(Sera) It's a good question, and even from my own view, kind of difficult to explain. I guess most of my drive comes from wanting to be another one of those renown Charr artists, since I love Charr so much myself. It was also something I loved doing a long time, but I just never really had the patience like I do now to draw at the level I do now.

(TC) Heh, well no argument about the charr being an inspiration. So you think age and time has kinda helped with the patience aspect of drawing?

(Sera) I would say so! I have definitely gotten more patient as I've gotten older, not to mention the shift in my activities. 10 years ago I used to live with family and started doing different activities like making money on Second Life, which ended up taking away nearly all of my creative time. Now that I have my own house and live alone, along with leaving Second Life due to it no longer being in my interests, I looked into getting back into drawing. I'm glad I did!

(TC) Mmhmm - quite a transition! And I've seen some of that happen in the years I've known you too. So this spawns a couple questions. First - do you see the art becoming something you're going to be doing more and more of, possibly a supplemental bit of work?

(Sera) I am going to be very careful on how I approach it. While I do enjoy the art, I can be easily susceptible to burnouts. I do take commissions, but only in two slots at a time so as to not overwhelm myself.

(TC) I think that's a wise way to do it - so many artists tend to make the mistake of opening the floodgates and then.... oi, easy to get too much on your plate. Okay second thing - back to the art itself, about how long does it take to do a piece like the charr ones you've done thus far?

(Sera) My first drawing of Isti took me 3 whole days to draw traditionally and the digital upgrade of it only took 1 whole day. Eona took 3 whole days to do both, and Esiryn only took 2 whole days to do both. I guess the armour really does add up the time!

(TC) I would think so - the armour is very elaborate and you detailed it out perfectly. Your transition to digital is pretty quick though, which is neat - but that has a lot to do with your actual career, yes?

(Sera) Sort of! a lot of the digital drawing experience came from just working with real photos and changing them heavily to look like something else without it looking like it was digitally altered.

(TC) Now... on the art itself (and.... because it's the Paw-Post) we gotta talk bout those paws! So far we've seen some awfully nice charr-feets, particularly with the sole-view in the Esiryn picture. Heh - normally I'd ask the artist if they're into feet at all or just like drawing them, but I

think we all know the answer to that with you. So... for you, being such a paw-connoisseur, does that make drawing them easier or harder?

(Sera) it is somewhat harder because of the very meticulous details that I take into account when drawing them. I must have gone back to Esiryn's foot and redrawn parts of it at least three times before I was finally happy with the end result. It's one of those parts where it has to be perfect in my overly critical point of view, otherwise it's not good enough.

(TC) Oh gods, I know what that's like - you've seen my redraw footpaws over and over and over trying to get them just right. You have a heck of a good eye for what constitutes a really attractive paw though, so the end result is amazing for the rest of us. :) What aspects of the paw do you like drawing the most and why?

(Sera) It has to be the pads themselves, both the foot and the toes. To me they are what make the paws, that and they are just my favorite part outside of drawing as well.

(TC) I think the love of them shows in how carefully you shape and detail them - the shape of Esiryn's show really well. It's nice to see because I've seen you do little sticky-note drawings of them now for years. :P So are you planning to stick with charr for a while then branch out?

(Sera) I will definitely be branching out! But my preference will be on Charr for the time being.

(TC) Now I can't help but wonder how that will translate to paws - do you think you'll tackle other species and types? *wiggles his toes* Dragon-dog C3s aren't too far off from charr, but C2s, or scaled soles would be different. Think you could do them?

(Sera) I welcome the challenge! but for now I will take the transition slowly and improve on other parts first. Muscle anatomy is one of my priorities if I am to take drawings like the one with Esiryn.

(TC) Anatomy is definitely tricky. What do you find the most challenging thing to draw at this time?

(Sera) right now it is getting the anatomy correct, but also the fact when working traditionally, you need to bare in mind of the limited space you have. you can't just add extra room to a physical canvas like you can digitally. Isti's horns were a casualty of that mistake, and I was too far into the picture to just start all over again.

(TC) Heh, I have done that far, far too many times. XD So... is there any advice you'd like to give people who might be struggling to return to art or do something similar to what you did?

(Sera) Don't push yourself to start again. If you have to think about whether or not you want to start drawing again and have your doubts, it's most likely not the right time yet. You know when it'll come to you, much like it hit me with wanting to draw charr. Getting back into drawing will be much more smoother when you wait for that right time.

(TC) Mmm, so sorta making sure you got your muse's thumb's up. Or paws up. Whatever. :P Now, I have a bit of inside knowledge/awareness here, so this is more for other's benefit - but you intend to keep your art SFW, even with paw stuff, right?

(Sera) Yes, any art that I plan to take will be kept strictly SFW. I also will not be doing any paw perspective either, since I do not feel comfortable with the idea, and perspective isn't something I'm good at anyway. There is of course no problem if a commissioner wanted the bottoms of the paws to be showing off in any way. My picture of Esiryn is a good example of what is acceptable.

(TC) Figured it'd be good to have that said and clarified. Even the blue Squirmly wants to keep the reasons a secret. *winks* Anyway, alright in rounding up - is there anything you'd like to say to your new (and growing) bunch of art fans?

(Sera) A big thank you for the interest and support! It really helps me with my motivation to draw more.

(TC) And we definitely look forward to more! Thanks for taking some time to sit with us again - and for all your past help too!
