About the Tour:

Embark on a magical winter adventure through Spiti Valley, starting in Delhi and journeying through Shimla, Chitkul, Nako, Gue, Key, Kibber, Kaza, Komik, Hikkim, Langza, Dhankar, and Kalpa before returning to Shimla and Delhi. It's a chance to breathe in the crisp mountain air, sip warm chai in local homes, and immerse yourself in the serene charm of Spiti Valley in winter.

- **Duration:** 09 Night, 10 Days
- **Start Point:** Chandigarh
- **End Point:** Chandigarh

DAY SCHEDULE

Day 1: Chandigarh To Shimla (111 km / 3-4 hrs)

- Today you will start your journey from Delhi bus station .
- Will depart at night from delhi in volvo bus.
- Reach Shimla in the morning.

Day 2: Shimla – Sangla - Rakchham (83 km / 4 hrs)

- Breakfast at Hotel
- Depart for Sangla via Rampur, jeori, Tranda Mata temple & Karcham.
- Stop for lunch on the way
- Stroll along the Baspa River, explore local market and village
- Leave for Rakchham in the evening towards your hotel.
- Check in at the hotel. Overnight Stay: Rakchham

Day 3: Sangla/ Rakchham Local Sight-Seeing

- Breakfast at hotel
- Visit Kamru Fort and temple
- Visit Batseri Village and Chitkul (last village on Indo-Tibetan border)
- lunch at chitkul famous Aakhri Dhaba
- Explore the local market and rakchham village in the evening.
- Return to Rakchham for dinner.

Day 4: Sangla – Nako – Tabo (160 km / 7-8 hrs)

- Morning: After breakfast, drive towards Nako Village.
- Visit the serene Nako Lake. Afternoon: Continue towards Tabo.
- En route, see the confluence of Spiti & Sutlej Rivers at Khab.
- Evening: Explore the 1000-year-old Tabo Monastery (UNESCO site).
- Overnight Stay: Tabo

Day 5: Tabo – Dhankar – Pin Valley – Kaza (70 km / 5-6 hrs)

- Drive to Dhankar Monastery, perched on a cliff.
- (Optional short trek to Dhankar Lake if time permits)
- Explore Pin Valley National Park — known for its wildlife and stunning landscapes.
- Evening: Arrive at Kaza, the heart of Spiti.
- Overnight Stay: Kaza

Day 06: Kaza – Local Sightseeing

- Morning: Visit the world's highest post office at Hikkim.
- Stop at Komic Village (one of the highest motorable villages).
- Explore Langza (known for its giant Buddha statue and fossils).
- Afternoon: Head to Key Monastery — the largest in Spiti.
- Optional visit to Kibber Village, known for snow leopards in winter.
- Evening: Return to Kaza for local shopping or café hopping.
- Overnight Stay: Kaza.

Day 07: Kaza To Kalpa(208 km / 8-9 hrs)

- Breakfast at a hotel.
- Depart for Kalpa via Nako, Khab, Pooh.
- In Afternoon explore Peo market & you can have local cuisine for lunch.
- Check into hotel in Kalpa
- Walk to the village to enjoy views
- Visit the local monastery
- Dinner at a hotel.

Day 08: Kalpa Local Sight-Seeing

- Breakfast at hotel
- Visit Suicide Point and Rogi the last village
- Visit to the most famous lord shiva temple in Roghi.
- Lunch at a local restaurant
- In the evening explore kalpa chilli village local market, Temple & Monastery.
- Dinner at hotel

Day 09: Kalpa To Sarahan(85 km/ 3 hrs)

- Start from Kalpa towards Sarahan.
- En route: Visit Narkanda and enjoy views of the Hatu Peak.
- Afternoon: Stop at Rampur Bushahr for lunch.
- Evening: Reach Sarahan, visit the Bhima Kali Temple.
- Overnight Stay: Sarahan

Day 10: Sarhan To Chandigarh (270 km/ 8-9 hrs)

- Early breakfast at hotel
- Depart for Chandigarh, Stop for lunch en route
- Arrive in Chandigarh, drop-off at designated location.

Travel Tips:

- ❖ · Permits: Check for permits required for Spiti and Chandratal.
- ❖ · Weather: Be prepared for temperature drops, especially at Chandratal.
- ❖ · Connectivity: Limited network in Spiti. BSNL works best.
- ❖ · Essentials: Carry basic medicines, sunscreen, and snacks.

How to reach:

- **By Air:** Indira Gandhi International Airport (IGI) in Delhi is a feasible option for traveling to Spiti as it serves both domestic and international flights.
- **By Rail:** Another alternative is the New Delhi Railway Station, through which most trains arrive and depart from Delhi to all around India.
- **By Road:** Delhi is well connected by bus to major cities like Jaipur, Agra, Alwar, Dehradun, and even Kathmandu, among others.
