## Sending a Letter

Sending letters to leaders, lawmakers and politicians is critical to spreading awareness of world federalism amongst decision-makers. To send a letter, follow these steps:

#### Mailing a Letter

- 1. Find the physical address of your recipient.
- 2. Copy the text below into a word document for printing.
- 3. Format the letter using formal letter rules. (English rules here.)
- 4. Print and sign your name.
- 5. Take a photo of your letter and share it with the Young World Federalists.
  - a. Note: Do not include your address in the photo!
- 6. Address the envelope and place it in the mailbox. (Tips here.)
- 7. Share any response with the Young World Federalists.

#### Emailing a Letter

- 1. Find the email address of your recipient.
- 2. Copy the text below into an email.
- 3. Fill in your name and the name of your recipient.
- 4. Send the email.
- 5. Screenshot your email and share it with the Young World Federalists.
  - a. Note: Do not include your email in the screenshot!
- 6. Share any response with the Young World Federalists.

### Sample Letter Text
