

# Clear the Air Community of Practice – How to Join

Cancer Council WA's Clear the Air Community of Practice is a free, private online engagement platform designed for staff and volunteers who work with young people, including those in health, community, youth, education and sports settings. It provides a space for connection, collaboration and knowledge-sharing to prevent vaping and support young people to break free from vaping (there will also be information and support relating to smoking and new and emerging nicotine products).

## How to join:

1. Please follow this [link](https://community-cleartheair.mn.co/) to the Clear the Air Community of Practice or go to:

2. Click the orange 'Join Now' button.
3. Click on the orange 'Access' button.
4. Create an account, using your first and last name, and email address. Click on the orange 'Create Account' button once complete.
5. You will come across a 'Accept Terms of Use and Select Email Options' pop-up.
  - Check the box 'By creating an account, I agree to Mighty Networks [Terms of Use and Privacy Policy](#)'. This is required to proceed with setting up your account.
  - Check the boxes for email updates and email lists if you would like to receive updates and stay connected to the Community of Practice (this is optional).
  - Click the orange 'Confirm' button.
6. You will arrive at a request to 'Secure Your Account'. Here, you will be asked to scan the QR code using your preferred authenticator app. This process works best if you are using a desktop computer or laptop to join the Community of Practice. You will need to use an authenticator app on your phone, such as Microsoft Authenticator or Google Authenticator.
  - If using **Microsoft Authenticator**:
    - i. Open the Microsoft Authenticator app on your phone and click on the QR code image at the bottom right of the phone screen.
    - ii. Hold your phone up to the computer/laptop screen to scan the QR code that is displayed on the web browser.
    - iii. A new line will appear in the Microsoft Authenticator app called 'Clear the Air Community of Practice' line. This includes a 6-digit code which will change every 30 seconds. Type this code into the 'Code' box on the Clear the Air Community of Practice webpage on your computer/laptop.

- If using **Google Authenticator**:
    - i. Open the Google Authenticator app on your phone and click on the + sign on the bottom right of the phone screen.
    - ii. Select 'Scan a QR code'.
    - iii. Hold your phone up to the computer/laptop screen to scan the QR code that is displayed on the web browser.
    - iv. A new line will appear in the Google Authenticator app called 'Clear the Air Community of Practice' line. This includes a 6-digit code which will change every few seconds. Type this code into the 'Code' box on the Clear the Air Community of Practice webpage on your computer/laptop.
  - Once the code has been entered, click the orange 'Enable Authenticator App' button.
  - Once your membership has been approved, you will be prompted to enter the code on your chosen authenticator app every time you wish to sign back in to the Community of Practice.
7. You will be asked a series of questions about your role and work. These questions are to ensure that the Community of Practice stays free from tobacco and vape industry interference (including industry funded front-groups).
  8. Once you have submitted your response to the questions, your request to join the Community of Practice will be reviewed by the Clear the Air team within 1-3 business days. We will email you with an approval to join the Community of Practice, or with additional questions in case we require further information.
