## Iridescent World

Take adventures with the Iridescent Guardians patrolling all of Ororai, and rally them to defeat the darkness encroaching all over.

### • What is Ororai?

The land was named after the auroras that constantly graced the night skies, which was believed to be the sign of the Celestium's approval. It was formerly called such after the establishment of Holopolis, under the orders of the first and current King, King Tanigo

Long ago, the King of Holopolis, King Tanigo, established the Iridescent Guardians, an order of individuals bound to serve and bring happiness to the lands far and wide in Aurorai. The King started with a young maiden called Sora Tokino and overtime, it expanded to encompass beings far and wide across Ororai.

#### • Who are the Celestium?

The Celestium are a pantheon of deities that keep watch over Ororai, and are venerated as gods and goddesses by all of Aurorai. They are:

- Covernius: the leader of the Celestium, the one that approached the king in his sleep about the foundation of the Celestial Guardians
- Auroia: Covernius second-in-command, always there to double check what Covernius enacts as a law. She is responsible for releasing the auroras into the Ororai skies.
- Nijongis: attributed with the Advent of language around Ororai, said to have delivered the ability as his first task as the speaker of the Celestium.
- Rojoris: the judge of the Celestium. He is in charge of making sure no evil escapes his sight. He believes that his peers have become too lenient upon the denizens of Ororai.

## Why the war happened

For eons, the denizens of Aurorai were happy and content with King Tanigo and the Iridescent Guardians. However, as with all kingdoms, dissidents rose, and were not satisfied with Holopolis' rule. Goaded on by the deity Rojoris, traitor to the Celestium, groups rose up to contradict the just rule of King Yagoo and Holopolis. He sounded his call by corrupting a passing Aurora, the very symbol of the Celestium's love and approval over the land of Ororai. With the power of the aurora, he then

proceeded to overpower his peers bar one, Covernius, who barely escaped. He now holds the other two captive.

The first such group to rise up was the malevolent Kingdom of Negazion, a people infamous for practicing dark arts, in particular, magic that weaponizes the secrets, fears, and insecurities of the victim. They soon launched a full-scale war against Holopolis, and they did not prevail.

Having been defeated, they have resorted to their dark magic and underhanded tactics. #### • Who are the threats?

As of writing, there are 3 major threats to Ororai, all vying to gain dominance of all the land. These are:

# Order of the White

An extremist clergy group that goes after Guardians that they deem inappropriate for their duties. They are zealots who despise any opposite gender interaction, even among fellow Guardians, deeming it detrimental to their duties.

As of late, their finest warriors have now used the power of the Dark Aurora for battle, believing that the citizens of Ororai have gone astray, and Rojoris will lead their crusade to victory.

# S'jawzonia

A kingdom where snake-bodied female warriors rule with an iron fist, every position of power is held by a woman, save for a token few held by men.

They oppose the Guardians, feeling that they have spat on the pride of a woman, and absolutely hates the male cadre of the Guardians. Has made moves to install their people as the Guardians, replacing the current ones, and by force if need be.

# Kingdom of Negazion

Ruled by the tyrant Vermel Darkstar, their mastery of dark arts is a chilling sight, and in particular their emotion magic, where they weaponize the doubts, fears, and secrets of their enemies, which include the Guardians and Holopolis as a whole.

Defeated in the war against Holopolis, they resorted to underhanded techniques and spies to carry out the tyrant's will. With such, they have managed to scatter the armies of Holopolis in chaos.

The Kingdom has the most advanced weapons in the war for Ororai, including the Dark Guardians soulless copies of Guardians, made after being drained of their negativities and attacked them with it.

- Celestium the order of deities that once stood watch over Ororai.
- Holopolis the capital city of Polaria, a righteous kingdom founded by King Yagoo
- King Tanigo the King of Holopolis
- Iridescent Guardian King Yagoo's most prominent stewards, making sure that the kingdom and the whole of Ororai are happy and lively
- Sora Tokino the first Iridescent Guardian, renowned for her singing talent
- Dark Guardians soulless copy of an Iridescent Guardian, standing for everything the original does not. Powered by the Dark Aurora
- Dark Aurora a cosmic abomination made by the traitor deity Rojoris to fuel the (???),

possibly on a level higher than the original Auroras.
