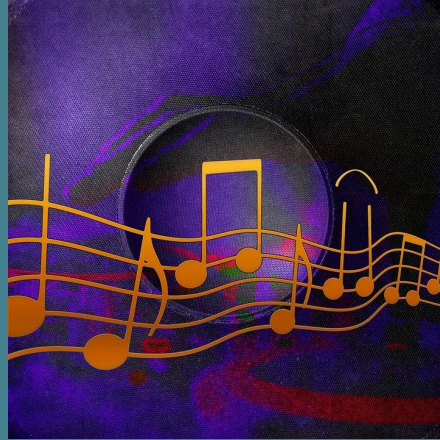


# Melody



Grade 6

Week #2

**OBJECTIVE:** students will compose a simple melody in the key of C.

**DIRECTIONS:** Read the information below and then click on the link for some helpful guidance to compose your own melody. When you finish, complete the google form by clicking on the link at the bottom of this doc.

Let's work a little more with melody and how to compose a song. Watch the video below for an example of how a song is made up of pitch and rhythm, then you are going to try to write a simple melody with lyrics and notes.

Now that you know how to make a simple melody, let's add some lyrics(words) to your song.

1. First pick a subject for your song
2. Write your first verse like a poem with a rhythm; it may rhyme or not.
3. Give each syllable to your song a note.
4. Use the following notes for your song: C,D,E,F,G,A B  
C
5. Start and end on C and your song will have a pleasing sound.

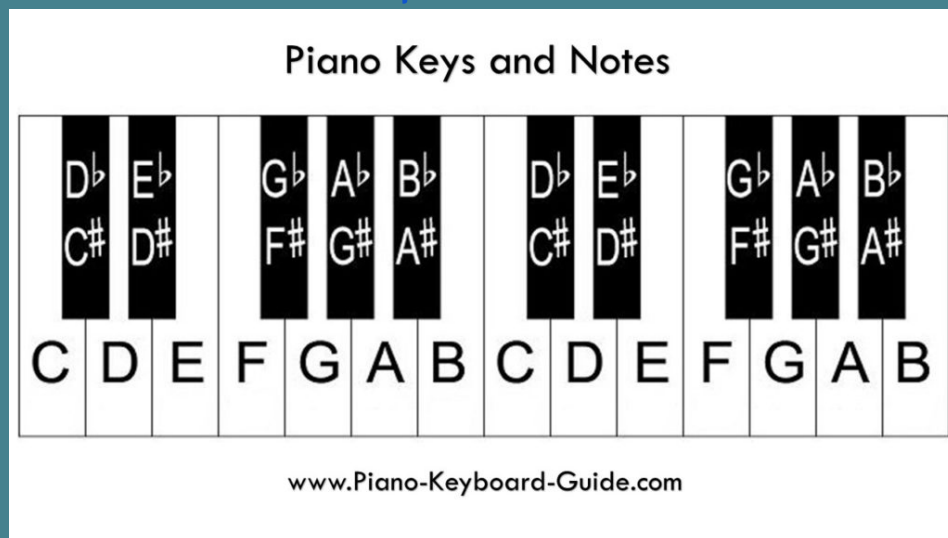
Use the virtual piano, or an instrument at your house to figure out the notes to your song.
