

Who: 8th graders going to 9th grade

What: TSIA2

When & Where: Jackie Caffey Junior High on January 14, 2025 or March 6, 2025

Why: TSI is a state assessment required to take college level coursework. Students particularly interested in taking academic college courses with ACC while in high school through the Dual Credit program are required to take this exam prior to course selection. Students testing for the first time must take the entire exam(all 3 parts). Your score will determine the courses you are eligible to take. Students should visit with the ACC Advisor after testing to review their results.

How:

- 1. Students will get a registration form from their counselor. TSIA Registration Form 24-25
- 2. Students must first have an application on file with ACC. Here is the link to apply https://www.alvincollege.edu/dualenrollment/
- 3. Students must take the Pre-Assessment Activity and provide certificate of completion to pay for the TSI. Here is the link for the assessment https://practice.accuplacer.org/login
- 4. Students pays the \$15 fee via <u>My School Bucks</u>. https://www.myschoolbucks.com/ver2/getmain.action?clientKey=&requestAction=home

- 5. Once they pay, the student will be directed to print the registration form. (It will be accessible online once they pay through my school bucks). The form will need to be filled out and signed by a parent and then brought back to the campus counselor with the receipt. The campus counselor will sign off on the registration form. - 6. Make sure you have printed or emailed all documents to Mrs. Fontenot in the counselor's office: TSIA2 Registration Form, ACC Application, My School Bucks Receipt #, Pre-Assessment Activity Completion Certificate(PAA) Deadline: January 9th & February 28th
