CALL TO ORDER

STANDING REPORTS

ASB Report

Coral Trip, ASB VP

Ren Rally Week was a success with themed days, including PJ Day and crazy sock day. Ren shirts were distributed. At the Ren Rally, which was Alice in Wonderland themed, there was a dunk tank. Our own Principal Gibbs and other teachers participated. Senior movie night was tied into the Alice In Wonderland Theme. Camp Week followed with traditional camp activities each day. Prom was a success and very fun. There were 396 students there. The theme was Masquerade. Planning and preparation are going on for Air Guitar. Senior Recess is this Thursday night. Grad night payments are in, they are just waiting for the tickets to come.

Staffulty Report

Yiu Hung Li

Mr. Li teaches English, as well as coordinating the Journalism and DTech programs. Students' psychological state is improving post Covid, but there are lasting impacts of Covid on school culture and student's frame of mind. Most kids have taken masks off in class and that has made a significant positive impact on student engagement and participation in class. The Journalism kids went to a conference in LA. This was the first time they've been able to go since the pandemic began. The Journalism program earned a Silver Crown, which is only granted to 18 schools in the whole country. Next year's conference will be in Seattle. The DTech program is a one-of-a-kind program. The program hasn't yet hit critical mass yet. The students are on track to sell approximately \$9000 in product that they've made. In the future, Mr. Li would like to include products made by DTech to sell in the auction fundraiser. DTech has made and sold products in businesses in downtown Ventura. Jen suggested that DTech send a rep to the PFSO meetings to identify ways that DTech could be engaged for PFSO activities – like the faculty t-shirts or other faculty appreciation items. Mr. Li will bring this request to the leadership group of DTech. Mr. Li mentioned that Journalism struggled to pay for the trip to the conference and asked if PFSO could help. The presidents will follow-up.

Treasurer

Our ending balance for March was over \$50,000. There are a few outstanding checks and outstanding deposits. We have over 90 RSVPs for the auction, but will have more expenses in April and May.

Jen asked how much is left in the Teacher Appreciation Budget and whether teacher tower is included in that or a separate budget line. Kerry will look that up and get back to Jen.

Principal's Report

Mr. Gibbs, Principal

The kids all had fun at prom. Everyone seemed to be having a great time and looked great.

Testing season has started with APs and state testing happening in the next few weeks.

Principal Gibbs will loop us into the planning for the first day packets, so we can distribute PFSO information. With Covid the past couple years have not followed the normal process. This year, we can hopefully be engaged earlier.

Barbara asked about enrollment, and whether FTHS will have reduced enrollment in the fall. Principal Gibbs has accepted students from the waitlist, so FTHS should be at capacity in the fall. Other high schools in the district are facing enrollment declines.

Sueanne mentioned concerns about the capacity for prom and shared that several students were unable to attend, even though students attempted to buy tickets before the published deadline, because of capacity issues. Principal Gibbs mentioned that turnout for prom was especially high this year, and due to Covid, venue options were limited. Capacity will be factored into decisions for the location of prom for 2023.
