<u>AI</u>

Jimmy Juliano and Jeff Summy spoke about Summer KTI's and how it was the most attended session during summer camp. Chat GPT was discussed and how it is being used at LFHS. 34 LFHS teachers have been granted premium to Chat GPT, giving them first hand experience in how Chat can be helpful to students and staff.

Corey Holmer spoke on Canva and how it has helped his class with Graphic design. He asked how students can be exposed to AI in a manner that is responsible, and how staff can provide guidance.

Stephen Dunn spoke on Conmigo, another AI tool, and how helpful this can be to all involved. Staff also spoke on other AI apps and their positive influence it will have on staff and students, as well as how and when they will be incorporated into our school.

PORTRAIT OF A LEARNER

Renee spoke on Portrait of a Learner and the work that Steve Dunn has accomplished with his team. A Capstone project with a student portfolio was discussed.

Steve Dunn spoke about his excitement in regard to Portrait of a Learner. He wants to be able to energize students and staff, with human connection while still using AI.
