## Principal Report (Don Gramenz)

- Blake Nellis is working with a second grade on their unit of Balance.
- This Friday, March 15th is Bring a Buddy Day: stuffed animal or something that can fit in their backpack
- Lots of events coming up: book fair, math night, Grandfriends day, etc. and Spring break
- Orchestra Hall was amazingly well prepared and did great being an audience member & role model for other schools there.

- In April Bob Lentz will begin implementation for the mural after gaining feedback from staff.
- Yearbook orders are due April 8, 2024!
- If you do before/after school care for Kids Safari, registration opens on April 8th for the 2024-2025 school
  year. Register early because it fills up quickly.
- The fifth grade starts testing two weeks after Spring Break. Three consecutive weeks of testing.
- Staffing/Rightsizing the Budget: overall Hillcrest equates to approx. 1.5 FTE to measure salary and benefits. Kindergarten enrollment went up by a handful. First & Second grades remain the same. We lost quite a few to Elements so there are two 3rd grade teachers. The amount right now is 32 students per section. Based on Right Sizing the Budget, if we added 1 more fifth grader for this fall, it would add another section as there are currently two. Some staff have needed to reduce their hours and, at this time, we no longer have three gen. ed paras we will have two next year. We continue to advocate for 5th grade and the whole school as best as we can.
- Parent volunteers can help at both recess and the lunchroom. You need to go through specific training for the lunchroom/food service piece.

### **Teacher Update**

- Grandfriends Day is open house style; they can go to the book fair and in the cafeteria for refreshments. It starts at 8:15 am and teacher contract time begins at 8:20 am. Upon arrival, they are welcome to go to the cafeteria first and it will close at 8:45 am to clean and get ready for Kids Safari breakfast at 9 am. Food will stay in the cafeteria to allow it to remain contained. Please remind grandfriends to arrive on time and not early as teachers/spaces may not be ready earlier than 8:20 am.
