- Entries must be submitted no later than the closing date
- Entry fees
 - \$80 for Derby
 - \$30 Non-Competing Horse
 - \$25 Administrative Fee (non-refundable)
 - \$15 Grounds Fee

REFUNDS

- Before closing date refund of entry fee minus \$25 Admin fee.
- After closing date no refund. Exception: If your spot can be filled from the waiting list, then refund of entry fee minus \$25 Admin fee.

STABLING

FOOD/BEVERAGES

ATTIRE

- Properly fitting ASTM/SEI approved helmet with permanent harness
- Bridle numbers must be fastened to bridle and clearly visible
- Riding coats are not required. A polo shirt with a collar may be substituted for a riding shirt however, T- Shirts are not acceptable
- Boots and breeches must be worn when competing.

SCHOOLING

- Available Friday before the show from 12 pm to 6 pm.
- Riders who school on Friday before the show are eligible for awards and prizes.

AWARDS AND PRIZES

- Ribbons for 1st through 6th place
 - Prizes for 1st place (sponsored by CTEA)
 - Prizes for 2nd place (sponsored by Crossgate Equestrian)

- Special Awards
 - Youngest competitor
 - Oldest competitor
 - Youngest horse
 - Oldest horse
 - Lowest dressage score across all levels
 - Closest to optimum time on Derby across all levels, with no jump or time faults

DIVISIONS

All Derby Divisions will consist of a Dressage Test and a Jumping Test.

- Dressage tests will be held in a 20m x 40m arena.
- Jumping test will be a combination of stadium and cross country fences.
 - Stadium fences will be at the beginning of the course and consist of approximately 7 fences. Stadium fences will be subject to stadium scoring penalties.
 - Cross country fences will be subject to cross country scoring for penalties
 - Speed and Optimum Times will be posted at the show.
 - ALL COURSES WILL BE INVITING AND APPROPRIATE FOR THE FIRST TIME AT THE LEVEL.

Jumping	Stadium: Verticals max 3', Oxers max 2' 9" Cross-country: 12 to 16 jumping efforts, max 3' 3"

NOVICE (black on white)	
Dressage	2022 USEF NOVICE Test A
Jumping	Stadium: Verticals max 2' 9", Oxers max 2' 6" Cross-country: 10 to 15 jumping efforts, max 2' 11"

BEGINNER NOVICE (black on yellow)	
Dressage	2022 USEF BEGINNER NOVICE TEST A
Jumping	Stadium: Verticals max 2' 6", Oxers max 2' 3" Cross-country: 10 to 14 jumping efforts, max 2' 7"

STARTER (white on orange)	
Dressage	2022 USEA STARTER TEST
Jumping	Stadium: Verticals max 2' 3", Oxers max 2' Cross-country: 10 to 12 jumping efforts, max 2' 3"

LEVEL 2 (black on purple)	
Dressage	<u>USDF 2019 Introductory Test C</u> Test may be called.
Jumping	Stadium: Verticals max 2', no oxers Cross-country: 8 to 10 jumping efforts, max 2'

LEVEL 1 (black on pink)	
Dressage	<u>USDF 2019 Introductory Test C</u> Test may be called.
Jumping	Stadium: Cross rails, cups at 2' max Cross-country: 8 to10 jumping efforts, max 18"
