LOCAL INFANTRYMAN WOUNDED IN ACTION IN PHILIPPINE REGION

Mr. and Mrs. Conrad L. Leinweber, 145 Sixth avenue, have been informed by the war department their son, Pfc. Harry A. Leinweber, 28, was slightly wounded in action in the Philippine area.

According to the official message, Private Leinweber was wounded on Mindoro, in the Philippines, on April 18.

He has been with the infantry and overseas 29 months. He entered service on Nov. 11, 1942, and was with the large group of Oshkosh young men who were sent to the Hawaiian islands, one month after induction.

The Oshkosh youth served in battles on New Guinea, Leyte, Luzon, Corregidor and Mindanao, in addition to his more recent service on Mindoro.

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
