Dear Parents/Guardians,

At WMS and WHS, the school nurse may administer Motrin (Ibuprofen) or Tylenol (Acetaminophen) to the student once during the school day for dental pain, headache, menstrual cramps or muscle soreness. Documented parent/guardian consent is required. Once consent is completed in the SNAP Health Portal it is valid for the remainder of the school year. Please make sure your consent is current and updated each school year.

How to Give Parental Consent for Motrin and/or Tylenol

1. Login to the SNAP Health Portal through PowerSchool.
2. Once in your student's profile, click the "Medications" tab in their Health Record.



3. To give consent for Motrin and/or Tylenol, click the "OTCs" button on the right hand side of the page.



4. Click "Opt-In" to give consent for Motrin and/or Tylenol for your student.
