

Good afternoon Conwell Tigers and Happy New Year!

We began virtual instruction yesterday, January 3, 2022, as an asynchronous day. Live instruction began today, Tuesday, January 4, 2022, for most classes. We are eagerly looking forward to returning to in-person learning on Monday, January 10, 2022. All supplies have been given out by the teachers over the past few days. Many teachers will be working remotely starting tomorrow, providing live instruction. If you did not receive the materials that are needed, you need to arrange the time that you will be picking up the materials with the teachers so they can inform the administration, office staff, and security that you will be coming to the school. Remote instruction is full day, 8:30am-2:45pm for K-5 and attendance is mandatory. Pre-K schedules have been provided by the teachers and will be followed as per state mandate to limit screen time to 60 minutes daily. The classes are broken into groups and teachers will provide 4 (approximately) 15-minute segments per day to each of the groups.

Please review the following reminders for the duration of virtual instruction:

- If you still need a chromebook, please contact the main office at 201-915-6100 between the hours of 9 and 11.
- The attendance policy is in effect. Attendance will be taken at the beginning of the school day. Students must keep their cameras on during live instruction.
- Teachers and students will follow their daily schedules. Students will receive two additional ten-minute breaks and their regularly scheduled lunch.
- Please look for updated information on our school website, Facebook page, Google Classroom, and/or Kaymbu.
- Classwork and assignments will be graded during virtual instruction. Please encourage your child to remain actively engaged during remote instruction.
- Breakfast and lunch will be served daily at 11:00 AM.

This, too, shall pass, however we are better equipped this time around and are already up and running with live instruction thanks to the incredible efforts of the PS#3 Teachers and Para-professionals.
