Topic	Teaching seniors how to set up a Facebook account
Audience	Senior Citizens

Learning Outcomes:

- **Specific** – Use Facebook to keep up with other people and post stuff
- **Measurable** – User will be able to look up a friend on facebook and post something without help
- **Assignable** – Our senior learners
- **Realistic** – Senior Citizens will be able to manage their account, message friends as well as share pictures and videos. user can log in and out of facebook, send friend requests, search for people, post pictures, and post statuses.
- **Time-related** – Achieve this in 30 minutes.

1 min	Add instructor as a friend	Hands on learning, modeling
1 min	Send instructor a message	Hands on learning, modeling
2 min	Post a status	Hands on learning, modeling
6 min	Look for and add known associates	Hands on learning, modeling
