- Ice requests (scraper etc.) seem to be a high priority and the justification is clear.
- Sam suggests we ask Technology for more detail and decide on funding allocation in November.

#### Vice President Update

- 5% more doing weekend only

# Membership Update

## **Facilities Update**

- Scraper is beginning to fail and Dan requests replacement ASAP
- The compressor went down last Sunday. Temporary loss of ice time. The sense is that we purchased a "budget" compressor and that the recommendation is that when replaced we would get a better unit.
- Dan is concerned about carpet and houses are also a concern and needing replacement soon.
- BOO was a success
- Other registrations are online. Lupus fundraiser currently undersubscribed.
- Request that coffee budge be shifted from Kitchen to Event Budget. Jared supports this move.
