It is much better to not format your text in a specific technique, instead, just leave it plain except that you really need to type certain words in a "special method", or to emphasize certain word or words. Italic is a must in typing non-English word. Arabic word is transliterated based on Arabic-Indonesian transliteration according to SKB 3 Ministers style (Riyadi, Fauzan, & Budiman, 2023).

An introduction of the paper (with a proportion of 15-20% of the whole article length) should clearly state the purpose of the paper. It includes background of the problem, state of the art at least 5 articles sourced from reputable international journals

or accredited journals for a maximum of the last 10 years, gap analysis with previous research, novelty, research objectives are clearly presented (expressed). All introductions should be presented in the form of paragraphs, not pointers (Ferrazzani, 2023).

Methods

The method section (with the proportion is 10-15% of the total article length) consists of a description of the type of research, research approach, data sources and legal materials, and data analysis methods.

Describe the research design and approach, research subjects/participants/informants and selection criteria, sampling technique, data collection procedures, research instruments, data validity/reliability procedures, and data analysis techniques. Provide sufficient operational details to ensure transparency and research reproducibility. State the ethical approval obtained, including the approval number and issuing institution, where applicable. Describe the use of informed consent and other ethical procedures. For low-risk studies without formal ethical approval, provide a statement confirming adherence to applicable ethical research standards.

Results and Discussion

Includes a description of the findings of the work that discusses sharply (What/How), its relationship with previous concepts / theories (Why), compares critically with the work of others, and strengthens or corrects previous findings (What else).

In-Text Citations

The citations and references should follow the style of APA 7th Edition (End note). Every source cited in the body of the article should appear in the References, and all sources appearing in the References should be cited in the body of the article. Use *Reference Management Software* such as Mendeley (<https://www.mendeley.com>), to manage the references for your paper. Use other published articles in the same journal as models.

Discussion contains an explanation of the results of research associated with the results of previous studies, critically analyzed and linked to relevant recent literature. The discussion section should at least contain (1) the **why** element, to see the relationship between the results obtained and the basic concepts and/or hypotheses. The discussion made must be supported by real and clear facts; and (2) **what else** element, related to whether there is conformity or contradiction with the results of other people's research (page number approximately 30-40%).
