

The FAFSA(Free Application for Student Aid) is required for college students to be eligible to receive grants and some scholarships, to be eligible for student loans, or to participate in a work study program.

On October 13th during Parent/Teacher Conferences, we will have a representative from Southern State Community College in the guidance office to help you and your senior student fill out your FAFSA.

This will be by appointment only, and space is limited. We will have three appointments available every half hour, starting at 4:30 and running through 6:30. Appointments will be scheduled on a first come first serve basis.

If you book an appointment you will need to bring the following information with you:

- Student Social Security Number
- Household parent's social security number and birthdate.
- Student's driver's license number
- Federal income tax information from 2021 for the student and parents.
- Untaxed income received in the household for the last completed calendar year (child support, veteran's benefits, social security, etc.
- Information on any investments or assets (not including the home).
