

Creative Poster Assignment: Endangered Species (Year-7)

Objective:

Design a poster that raises awareness about an endangered species and encourages people to protect it.

Step 1 – Choose Your Species

- Pick one endangered animal or plant (example: Giant Panda, Sea Turtle, Snow Leopard, Orangutan, etc.).
- Make sure every individual has a different species if possible.

Step 2 – Research Your Species

Find simple but important facts:

- Name and picture of the species.
- Habitat (where it lives).
- Diet and special behaviors.
- Reasons it is endangered (hunting, pollution, climate change, deforestation, etc.).

Step 3 – Design Your Poster

Your poster must include:

1. Title – Catchy heading (e.g., “Save the Sea Turtles!”).
2. Drawing of the species.
3. Threats – Why it is endangered.
4. Conservation Message – Slogan or call to action (e.g., “Protect Our Planet,” “Don’t Let Them Disappear”).
5. Creative Elements – Colors, drawings, symbols (trees, oceans, earth, etc.).

Step 4 – Creativity Tips

- Use large fonts so words are easy to read.
- Make it colorful and eye-catching.
- Keep information short and simple (posters should not be full of long text).
