The Walnut Creek School District has set December 11, 2023 – March 1, 2024 as the time for the District's annual
KINDERGARTEN /TRANSITIONAL KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION.

Transitional Kindergarten

Parents of children who will turn five years old between September 2, 2024 and June 2, 2025 may register them for transitional kindergarten classes scheduled for the 2023-2024 school year. Registration will take place online beginning on December 11, 2023 and will be conducted in coordination with your school of residence.

Kindergarten

Parents of children who are five years old on or before September 1, 2024, may register them for kindergarten scheduled for the 2024-2025 school year. Registration will take place online beginning December 11, 2023, and will be conducted in coordination with your school of residence. A health examination report is recommended before school starts for the 2024-2025 school year and is required within three (3) months of entering first grade. This health exam may be scheduled as early as six (6) months before starting kindergarten or after February 20, 2024. A dental health screening is required by May 31, 2025 for transitional kindergarten or kindergarten students and may be scheduled as early as twelve months prior to the start of school. A doctor's name and telephone number and the name and telephone number of at least two people to contact during school hours if parents/guardians cannot be reached is needed to complete registration. The medical and oral health exam forms are available on the District web site by following this link to [Medical and Dental Forms](#).

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS – Each family is required to submit valid proof of residency. Please review our residency requirements by following this link to access [Residency Requirements](#).

Proof of birthdate/age must be presented at the time of registration by one of the following items: Birth record, birth certificate, passport, baptism certificate, or affidavit of the parent/guardian/custodian of the minor. Also required are records of immunizations issued by a physician or registered nurse, stating the month, day and year of each immunization, as follows:

Polio	4 doses at any age, but... 3 doses meet requirement if at least one dose was given on or after the 4 th birthday.
Diphtheria, Tetanus and Pertussis	5 doses at any age, but... 4 doses meet requirement if at least one dose was on or after the 4 th birthday.
Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)	2 doses , both on or after the 1 st birthday. Second dose must contain measles vaccine.
Hepatitis B	3 doses
Varicella (chicken pox)	2 doses or health care provider documented varicella disease or immunity.
