1. IoT Developer Survey

The survey has been a great success! More than three time responses than in 2018, and two times more complete responses recorded. The results of the analysis will be released on April 1st.

2. iot.eclipse.org discussion

We discussed the proposal [described in the slides](#). It was generally well received. The participants proposed a few ideas to further improve the website, such as:

- Feature videos on the front page
- Tweak the existing *Videos* section to filter the videos based on categories

- Have a Twitter feed on our website to echo the social media outreach of our projects. Whatever we do, however, needs to be GDPR-compliant.
- Attract attention to our virtual meetups.

Changes to enable participants to submit news and events will be implemented by March 22. As a first step, this will simply be GitHub issue templates that the WG members can use.

Ian Craggs announced that version 5.0 of the MQTT protocol [has been approved as an OASIS standard](#). Eclipse Paho is already compliant, and Eclipse Mosquitto is actively working on support.
