The state FFA staff will run a plagiarism report through The AET for proficiency, Agriscience Fair, Star, State Degree, and National Chapter applications. It will



screen all applications and match it to other applications in The AET. The report will flag 50 consecutive characters, which is about 3-4 sentences, and link it to the application with the same pattern.

The results of the report will be reviewed by 5 people consisting of state FFA staff and representatives from the FFA Board of Directors who do not have a member included on the report. Applications flagged as plagiarized may be disqualified or dropped rating/ranking levels.
