Credits	Content Area	Courses
4	English	English I, II, III, IV
4	Math	Math I, II, III and a 4 th Math
3	Science	Earth & Environmental (or AP Environmental), Biology, and a physical science (physical science, chemistry or physics)
4	Social Studies	World History, Civic Literacy, American History, Economics and Personal Finance
1	Health and PE	Health and PE
6	Specified Electives	Minimum 2 must be from either Arts, CTE, ROTC or World Language. Other 4 can be from any area above except PE
6	Electives	From any content area
	CPR	Successful completion of CPR requirement (usually done in 8 th grade)
	EOC	Students must show mastery with a score of Level 3, 4, or 5 on English, Math, and Science EOCs
Total	28 Credits	Maximum potential (32) minus four

- Courses may be taken at the CP, Honors, or Advanced Placement level (or CCP) if offered.
