Sure, the magic lotion works wonders, but they never bother checking on her, but wait for her to come down in the morning. Along the way you realise there's no reason for any canon characters to be there beyond Robin and Batman. Problem is, the authour seems to have realised that too, and much of the plotting is weak excuses to keep everyone else out of the way."

"And that seems to be it. Thanks as always," the Voice said.

"We should probably thank him for letting us use the apartment," Tsuneo said, gesturing at the paperwork spread out behind them.

"Naw, you'll just give him a big head," Dan replied. "If he has one."
