Russia's invasion of Ukraine is now well into its fourth year. And the Ukrainian people bravely fight on, [even in the face of horrific attacks on civilians](#). But there are serious concerns they'll have to do so moving forward without the help of the U.S. government.

Trump and his administration seem bound and determined to push Kyiv into handing Putin a victory Russian troops have not won. They have [parroted Moscow's propaganda](#), attempted to pressure Ukraine into a [neocolonial surrender of its natural resources without security guarantees](#) and bully President Zelensky in the Oval Office, and have [repeatedly cut off aid to our allies](#) as they struggle for their lives.

We learned last week that the Pentagon has halted supplies for the third time in six months, [holding back promised anti-aircraft and anti-missile defense systems](#) even as [Russia launches some of the worst aerial attacks of their war](#). While the administration claims [this is out of concern about the U.S. military's stockpiles being depleted](#), an analysis by senior military officers found the [aid package would not jeopardize our own supplies](#). [Democrats](#) and [even congressional Republicans aligned with Trump](#) accused [Hegseth and policy chief Elbridge Colby of putting this halt in place unilaterally without notifying the rest of the administration](#).

If the war continues, we cannot abandon our friends. That would be a gift to Putin that comes at the expense of freedom, democracy, global peace and U.S. national security interests.

The White House may have switched sides in this war, but the American people have not. Let's take this moment to contact our members of Congress and urge them to vote for and insist on aid to Ukraine.

The shipments Pete Hegseth unilaterally halted must be released immediately, and we must investigate reports that he and key aides made this decision without coordinating with or notifying the rest of the administration.

It will also send a message to Russia, China and the rest of the world that wars of conquest like this one are winnable and America does not have the backbone to stand up to them. A defeat for Ukraine will encourage more invasions in the future and make war over Taiwan more likely. It would be a disaster for our national security. We cannot let it happen.
