SYNOPSIS

VISUAL ANALYSIS

The embroidery fabric → square pattern

→ linework showing the lines and holes of the pattern.

The embroidery → colors & criss cross stitch texture

→ noisy brush to draw crosses or photo overlay.


The unravelled strands → highlight them, use their silhouette.

Interaction = embroider stitch by stitch via clicking.
