I'm so excited about your upcoming arrival at Interlochen, and I hope you're excited too!

I'm sharing with you a few important reminders and announcements. First, if you have not completed your required forms, please do so as soon as possible. Our Health Services team must review all health forms before the start of the Academy — please help us by completing these forms now.

Your health and wellness are our top priority, and we offer a range of services to support you, including School Counselors, the Dennison Center for Recreation and Wellness, Health Services, and our Residence Life Staff. In addition to these on-campus resources, I'm excited to announce a new addition to our support systems through a partnership with Uwill. Uwill offers free, immediate access to teletherapy and mental health services. Upon your arrival on campus, you'll have access to a range of tools through Uwill, including the ability to schedule an appointment with a therapist based on your needs and preferences, as well as a 24/7 support line for mental health emergencies.

Returning students, please note: the Uwill teletherapy program will replace our Ulliance teletherapy program. We will continue to partner with HelloHero for nurse practitioner medication management.

These teletherapy and telemedicine programs are part of our continued commitment to your well-being. I look forward to sharing more details about these programs and how to access the services during your first weeks at the Academy.

She earned her doctorate in Clinical Psychology from the University of Michigan, has been a fellow at Yale's Edward Zigler Center in Child Development and Social Policy and the University of Michigan's Power Foundation. And – she has served as a consultant to Pixar on the film *Inside Out 2*. She is a proud parent of two daughters. We are thrilled to have her join us during Family Weekend.
