NAME BC 2020 AGM President's Report:

Mothership News (from board meetings and online conversations)

Ongoing Issues/Discussions

• Strategies for recruiting and holding members:

- BC NAME memberships offered as door prizes at workshops and at reduced rate for presenters at the Virtual Panel Discussion in August.
- Speaker Series to provide ongoing educational opportunities to members
- Expanding our reach through working partnerships for example: with World Fisheries Trust (WFT), Canadian Network for Ocean Education (CaNOE) and UBC to plan and deliver the 2020 Virtual NAME conference in BC and an in-person &/or virtual conference in BC in August 2021.
- NAME has accepted the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between BC NAME and CaNOE.



Strategies to improve Communications:

- revision of logo by Hjalmer Wenstob is close to completion and will then move forward to unveil at the 2021 Conference;
- build new logo into a set of new swag, generic business cards, banners
 etc. that are "ready to go" to help promote NAME at more events;
- Yuko helped Jenny Huntley develop NAME WA Facebook page as a template for other chapters to use
- Note: flashmail coordination has not yet been resolved. We are still trying to find someone. Amy Sprenger indicated that she would start the process[JM1].
- Action Item: We need a dedicated "point person" to receive and post BC chapter news and events and keep our virtual postings current. (Jenn, said she can provide support to that person[JM2])
- Need continued follow up on top four mothership goals identified in 2019:
 - set target goals for chapter events/year (7)
 - \circ increased recruitment of youth members (6)*
 - o increased ethnic diversity (6) amongst members
 - $\circ\,$ better use of communications platforms to amplify opportunities (5)*

*Partnership with World Fisheries Trust and the young, tech savvy team helped us to meet some of these goals



A working group is in the process of revising our mothership strategic plan to address these issues; Communications goals & strategies have emerged as top priorities moving forward. The Speaker Series, that starts December 14 at 7pm is one step towards addressing communication.

• Action Items for chapters:

- Gloria Snively storybooks & resources were distributed to WA, OR & AK sales of books contributing to education fund: follow up as to their current numbers of copies/sales needs to be done;
- Cathy has attached a summary of NAME BC inventory of GS resources
- Insurance a non-issue this year, due to COVID but chapters usually send details about events to Rob Coates so he can satisfy insurance requirements;
- Spreading the word about NAME and our new Speaker Series within all of our networks;
- Keeping our virtual communications active and current;
- Resolving the Flashmail coordinator position.

Mothership Events 2020:

- Mid-year meeting Feb. 6, 2020 (4 BC reps)
- NAME is proposing to co-host our 2023 conference with the National Marine Educators Association (NMEA) in July 2023, at the Western Washington



University in Bellingham, WA. A working group has been struck and planning is already underway.

In partnership with CaNOE, WFT and UBC, NAME planned and delivered a virtual panel discussion on Wednesday, August 19, 2020 – 'Integrating virtual and hands-on marine education: experiences, reflection, and addressing challenges' Almost 60 participants registered and 33 new NAME members and renewals from BC, WA & OR were recruited.

Our NAME Summer Board Meeting was held virtually on Monday, August 17, 2020.

NAME BC Chapter Events 2020:

- All year sales of Gloria's storybooks & teacher resources has been on hold since cancellation of planned, in-person events. All inventory is stored in WestWind's office.
- Feb. 13, 2020 Teachers Workshop with a Seaquarium Touch Tray and hands-on experiences at Tupper HS in Vancouver with about 4 student teachers and 12 registrants attended. Thanks to Maia & WFT for delivering a first-rate workshop!
- Other workshops scheduled after March 10, 2020 were cancelled (e.g. Sooke Community Group, World Oceans Days at the Gorge and Fishermen's Wharf, Seaquaria teacher workshops etc.) because of early closure of BC in response to the Coronavirus Pandemic. Many of these events were done in partnership with WFT. We would like to post a note on our BC Chapter page thanking them for their support and encouraging other institutions to likewise step forward.



 World Fisheries Trust secured an NSERC Partnership Grant to work with NAME BC and CaNOE to help plan and deliver the Virtual Panel Discussion. This allowed Maia to take a leadership role as co-ordinator and so much more!
