- Set-up lights in the house

- Turn down water heater
- Turn off AC and water
- Make sure security system and cameras are working

Packing tips

- Portion out only what you need. Instead of bringing a full bottle of ketchup, decant only what you need. Same with maple syrup, mustard, salt, herbs, seasonings.
- Premix/premake whatever you can. I bring my pancake dry ingredients pre-mixed to skip that step and only carry what I need. You could even add the wet ingredients and store it in your cooler. Natascha premixes her scrambled eggs with cheese.
- Lint and paper towels rolls make great fire starters
- Pickup water and firewood closer to campsite to conserve fuel and packing space. We've comfortably sat with two bundles of wood on our laps for the last 30 minutes of a drive into a campsite. Some
