

I've exported my version of [Core 6k Optimized Japanese Vocabulary Anki deck](#)(removed) with audio. Mainly, the format's different from all those floating around. First of all, the background is white instead of yellow or black. You're presented with the sentence, target word in bold, and the answer contains the readings, a translation of the sentence, and the target word's English definition. This way you just focus on reading. It's easy, and it gets the words into your head. The sentences give context, which is crucial for good understanding.

To grade it, I give Easy if I understand (and can read) the target word, Very Easy if I understand the whole sentence, otherwise Again. Although if the interval is less than 7 days, I give Hard instead of Again, to avoid failing the same cards day after day.

tl;dr: read the sentence, rate your understanding of the bold word

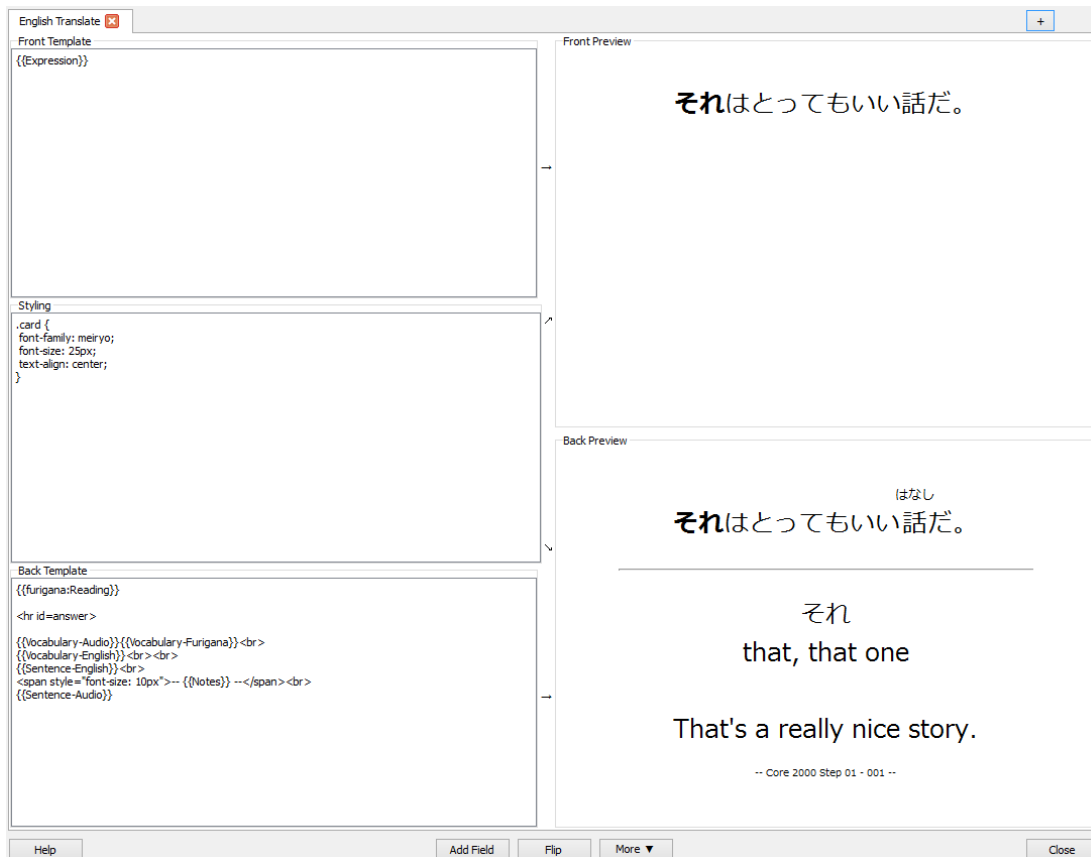
Disable audio autoplay in Deck Options > General.

Importing this may mess with any version of this deck you currently have (gj Anki), so use a test profile or something if you're just checking it out.
