Dear 6th grade families,

As we get closer to 6th graders going on outdoor education, the health room is requesting that all medication forms and medications be turned in by: April 11, 2025. For safety reasons, please do not send medication with your child to school. All medication must be delivered to the health room by an adult. Please ensure that over the counter medications are unopened and unexpired. If your child takes prescribed medication at home before school or after school hours, please ensure that your medical provider completes [MCPS Medication Form 525-13](#). All prescription medication must be in its original pharmacy bottle with a current prescription label and ensure it is not expired. If your child already has a daily or as needed medication at school and they are attending outdoor ed, this medication will be packed for the trip by the health room.

Montgomery County Public Schools uses the online payment system called **SchoolCash Online** as its preferred method of payment for school-related fees such as fundraisers, field trips, obligations, etc. (Please note that the new payment system is NOT related to school cafeteria accounts)

SchoolCash Online helps parents/guardians and community members pay school-related fees safely, quickly, and easily. SchoolCash Online will help increase efficiency and security at schools by making payments directly into schools' bank accounts and eliminating the need for teachers to handle money. In addition, once registered, you will be immediately informed about school activities!

Powered by KEV Group, SchoolCash Online is the industry leader in the management of school fees. The new system puts all of the school-related fees online for purchase so users can make purchases online using a credit card or echeck. A processing fee will be included on all items available for purchase, regardless of the type of payment used on SchoolCash Online or at the school.
