# Read Harder Challenge

This school year, we are asking our students to read differently. We want them to have the freedom to read what they want, but we are challenging them to read something outside their comfort zone; to expand their reading horizons and try some new genres. To track their reading progress, we are using the Renaissance program. Upon completion of a book, students are asked to pass an AR quiz with a score of 80 or above in order to count that book in their reading log.

Regardless of how many genres they choose to read, they will be held accountable for reading every day during silent sustained reading time in History/Social Studies class.

Classrooms are competing against each other, by grade, to see which class can log the most books. Prizes are awarded to students in the winning classes each 9 weeks. In addition to the classroom competition, the individual students who have read the most words will be rewarded at the end of the school year.
