	Imperfective	Perfective
Future Tense	Future Activity without Reference to Completion – here the activity is the ultimate focus. Whether some action will be completed is not is left unspecified. <i>V sobotu večer nejspíš budu číst.</i> On Saturday evening I will most likely read. Frequent Activity – here more emphasis is put on the activity itself rather than any ultimate completion of an action. <i>Příští týden budu vstávat každý den v půl šesté, protože budu pracovat ráno.</i> Next week I will wake up every day at 5:30 because I'll be working in the morning. <i>Příští týden budu dělat domácí úkoly asi každý večer.</i> Next week I will do homework probably every evening.	Action Will Be Completed – plan, intention, or similar statement that an action will be completed. <i>Přečtu ten článek dneska večer.</i> I will read (through) that article tonight. <i>Napíšu Honzovi v pátek.</i> I'll write Honza on Friday. <i>Udělám to zítra.</i> I will do that tomorrow.
