4.10 - slušet - 'to suit (someone)'

You find a piece of clothing that really looks good on someone (or yourself!). You want to express this. One way to express this in Czech is to use the verb *slušet* - 'to suit (someone)'.



The verb *slušet* 'to suit (someone)' is what you'll need to use for this. Like <u>the verb *libit* se</u>, the verb *slušet* will be used with the dative case (to make sense of it, you have to think of it being something like *it is suiting* **to** *you*, or something like that).

Take a look at some of these sentences:



Haně sluší ten kabát. That coat suits Hana (i.e. looks good on Hana).



Ty sluneční brýle ti moc sluší. Those sunglasses suit you (i.e. look good on you).
