

6.3 - Introduction to going with *jít* 'to go (by foot)'

jít 'to go (by foot)'

The verb *jít* 'to go (or to come)' is conjugated as follows:

(já)	jdu	(my)	jdeme
(ty)	jdeš	(vy)	jdete
(on/ona/on o)	jde	(oni/ony/ona)	jdou

If you want to ask where someone is going, you use the word *kam* 'where'. We already know the word *kde* 'where', so what's the difference?

kde - location - 'where (at)'

Kde jsi?

'Where are you?'

kam - destination - 'where (to)'

Kam jdeš?

'Where are you going?'
