- We use our internal DW for enrollment, outcomes, persistence, awards, equity research, extensive AB 705 research, enrolment management...and this data is the infrastructure for our Power BI LIbrary
- Used for enrollment, outcomes, longitudinal tracking, etc
- Used for research requests, dashboard development and other analysis. Setup includes both snapshot and cohort-based data elements and student tracking
- Used to to report data to state, NSC and other 3rd parties. The DW is the data source for canned reports to our colleges, then they use data for their needs.
- For program review, dashboards, balanced scorecards, ad hoc research & reports

Additional Feedback

What other information would you like to share with the Chancellor's Office and CCC Technology Center related to the DW accessibility and use to maximize equitable student outcomes? ¹

- I really want MIS data accessible in CO data warehouse. I want to see the unitary data behind all of the statewide dashboards like student success metrics be made available in it as well.
- We would only use the CCC Data Warehouse for data we don't already have, such as LGBTQ, Canvas, and COCI. We have less interest in pre-built reports as we do with the actual raw data.
- This will be most useful once Student Success Metrics are incorporated into the data warehouse. There is a lot of program review and continuous improvement that we could do using these metrics if we were able to link to our local data
- All data needs to be student level data. We need student IDs or SSN to be able to combine with our internal data. Aggregated data that is not student level is not useful to us.
- Access to DW is important and we will use it. However, access is very content specific and happens often at the district and not the college. We are looking forward to getting access the Canvas data.
- Preference is for a direct connection from CCCCO data warehouse to the local data warehouse.
- Need training on how to use it.

- 2. Work with Chancellor's Office to support access to data sets identified by college and districts.
- 3. Work with Chancellor's Office to develop communications and training support for the CCC DW
