REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

2026 Atlantic City Sports Offshore Grand Prix

RWO REGISTRATION:

Complete your registration online at raceworldoffshore.com/atlantic-city-registration

1. Fill out the Race Event Registration Form.
2. Complete the member registration form for each riding crew member and for anyone who will be present in the restricted crane area.
3. Add one Race Event Payment and the total number of memberships to your cart and submit as a single payment.

APBA REGISTRATION:

Complete your APBA registration at apba.tracksideapp.com/memberships

1. Renew your APBA membership or create a new APBA member account.
2. Submit your current medical certificate and capsule certificate, or a swim test if you are racing an open canopy boat.

UIM REGISTRATION (Class 1):

All Class 1 competitors must have a valid Super License prior to competing. Not required for Class 2 or Super Cat for the 2026 season.

Class 1, Class 2, & Super Cat competitors must sign the UIM consent form on-site.

EARLY REGISTRATION ALLOWS FOR:

- Dry pit layout and location assignments
- Paperwork prepared for team onsite registration process
- Promotion of the number of teams and boats per class
- Digital scoring paperwork to be uploaded to software
- Entry lists to be submitted to media outlets
- Correct number of awards and flags ordered

Competitors must complete at least 70% of all 2026 APBA National races (3 out of 4 events) to qualify for the championship.	No minimum requirement — the title is awarded purely on cumulative points. RACE FUEL PURCHASE REQUIREMENTS

Each team is required to purchase a minimum amount of fuel on site. When Southern Racing Fuels completes their weekend calculations, any team that did not purchase the minimum requirement will be invoiced for the required amount.

RULES & PROCEDURES

Mandatory Meeting: All drivers & throttlemen on Saturday; Saturday physicals for Sat. racers only

Role Call will be the first item on agenda both days. Driver of record will acknowledge when called, with last name.

A substitute driver or throttleman for test-day or race day must meet all the same qualifications as driver/throttleman and be cleared through administration with an arm band.

Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated and will be met with swift and appropriate action by RWO.

Oil Disposal – Teams will be responsible to dispose of their own oil responsibly. If necessary, find a local auto parts store and dispense of your used oil safely.

Rule Briefs – APBA rules are stated in full in the official online rule book. Any comments by officials in the driver's meeting is to be recognized and followed.

Event Changes – Details in this packet, online or posted at event could change due to many reasons. RWO will work to ensure changes are communicated to teams.

RACE CANCELLATION

Please be advised that the safety and well-being of all participants is our foremost priority. We reserve the right to cancel the race in the event of harsh or unsafe conditions, including but not limited to severe weather, environmental risks, or any unforeseen hazardous situations. In such cases, while we regret any inconvenience caused, please understand that the decision to cancel is made with the participants' safety in mind. Please note that race entry fees are non-refundable, as they are used in advance to cover the costs of race preparation and administration. RACE DAY CHECKLIST

2026 Atlantic City Sports Offshore Grand Prix



CHECKLIST

- ☐ Monitor 78A & EZAlerts (Text: ezac26 to 828-499-8660)
- ☐ Crane priority is for the boats of that race & time
- ☐ Props and straps ready before arriving at crane
- ☐ VBox / data logger SD card installed
- ☐ Cameras and SD cards ready and equipment on
- ☐ Always be ready to launch early with changing event conditions
- ☐ Milling direction is in the same direction of the race course
- ☐ Orange smoke – Stay milling, but prepare to get on plane and start Race
- ☐ Red flag to yellow flag in milling circle, means be prepared to move
- ☐ 100 feet behind pace boats
- ☐ Observe finish line every lap for checkered flag, this stops the race in addition to red flag
- ☐ Red flag – Come off plane return to center of course, monitor 78 A
- ☐ Count your laps and do not run extra laps. A checkered flag may not be thrown for your class winner
- ☐ Wide berth to hovering helicopter or safety boats in race course
- ☐ After the checked flag, boats must turn to the inside of the race course
- ☐ No passing within your class in a caution zone

CHECKERED FLAG PROCEDURE

In the event of multiple classes running in the same race, the checkered flag will not be waived until the first place boat of the slowest class crosses the finish line finishing their final lap. However, if a lapped boat in a faster class is crossing the finish line at the same time, the flag will not be waved to ensure that boat completes its lap. When the checkered flag waves the race is over and all scoring is completed.

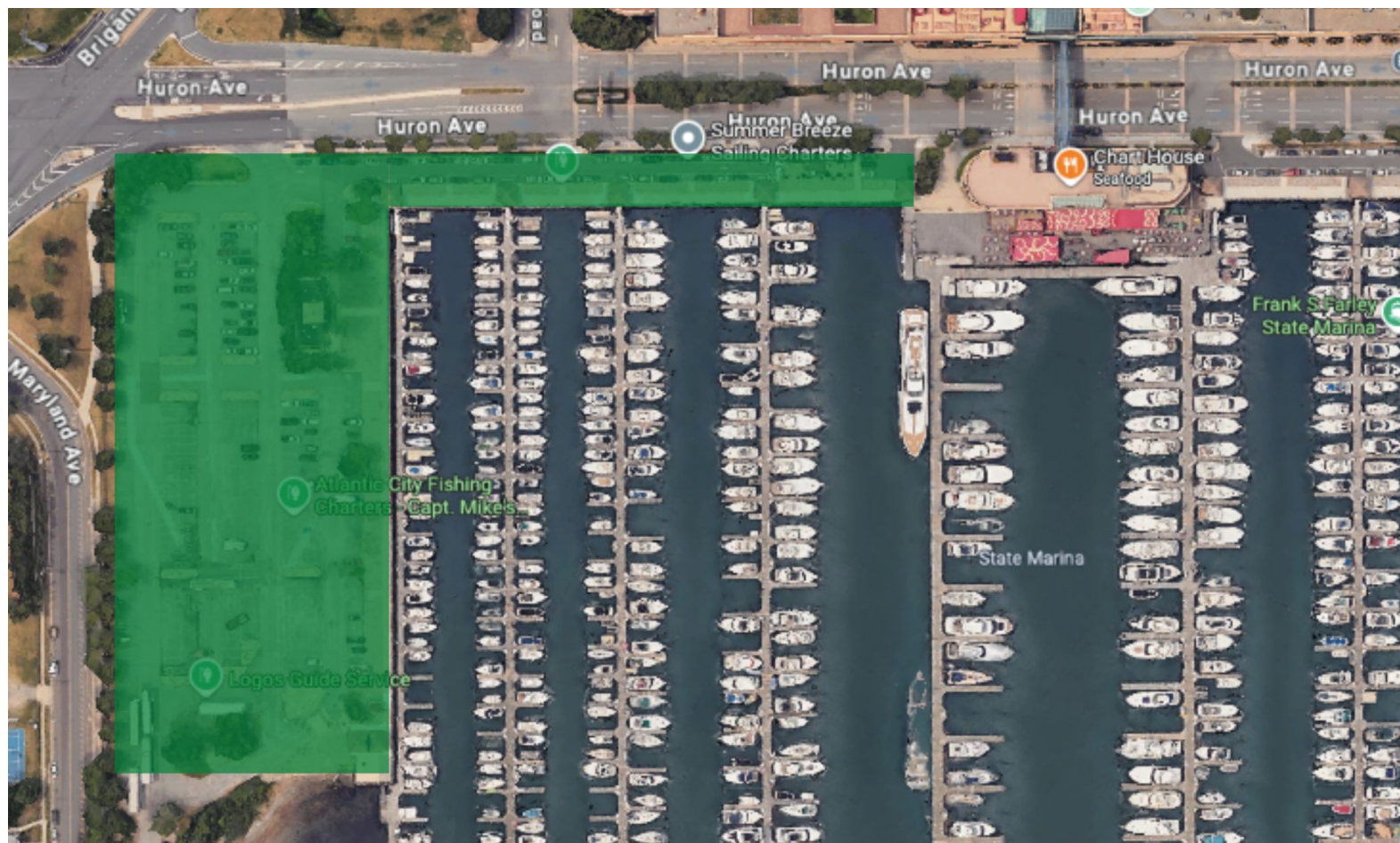


DRY PITS MAP & RAMP

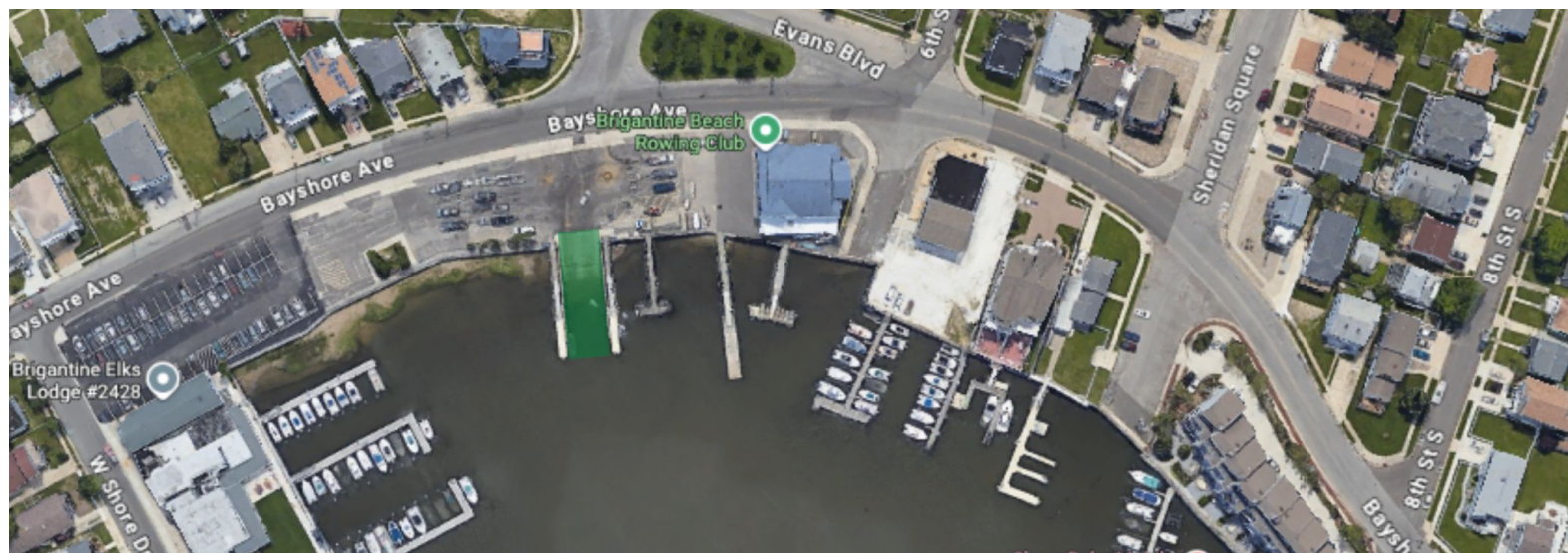

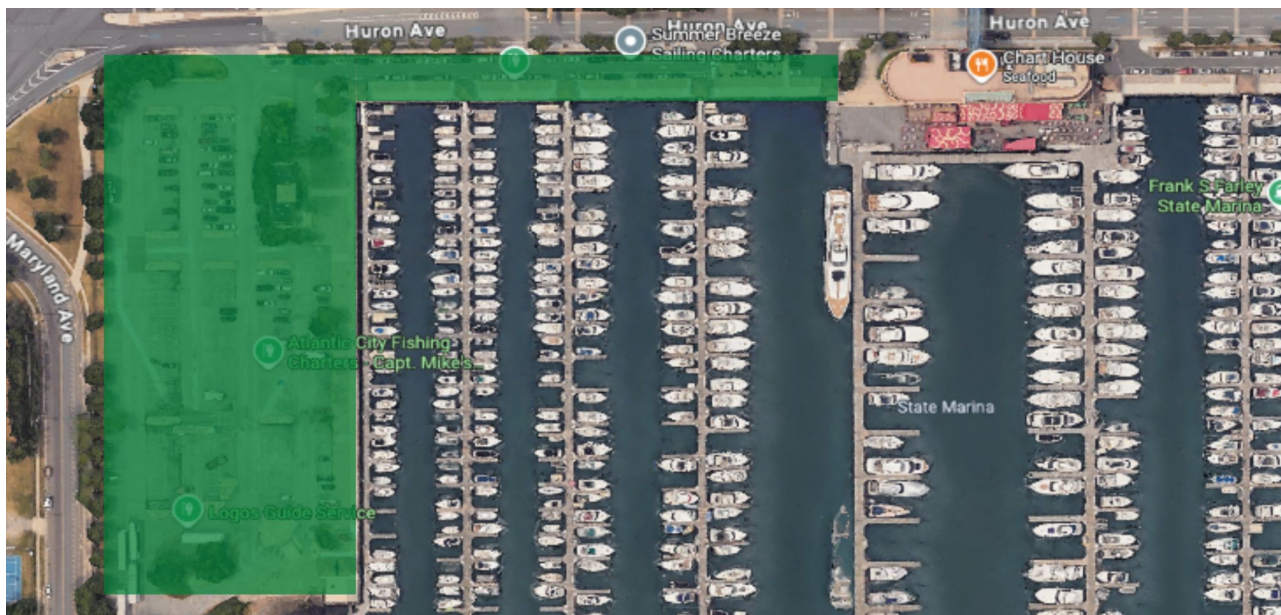
Instructions: Complete all the checkboxes below pertaining to both the Technical Inspection and Safety Inspection requirements. After your team has completed and filled in the entry blanks below, turn this form in to the RWO Inspection Trailer.

Important Note: Crew chief and mechanic will be required to take their boat to the designated area for a complete inspection when called. This is **first come first serve process** once your pass is turned in. Teams shall not move their boat until notified by an inspector. Teams will only be called during posted inspection hours.

- Airport Dry Pitting Boats you will drive to inspection trailer
- Get this EZ Pass paperwork to the RWO Technical Inspection Trailer
- An Inspector will call you when you are to be staged next in line
- Do not drive to inspections until you are called on the phone by an Inspector
- This is a first come first serve basis. Turn your paperwork in hours in advance
- Do not wait until the last minute

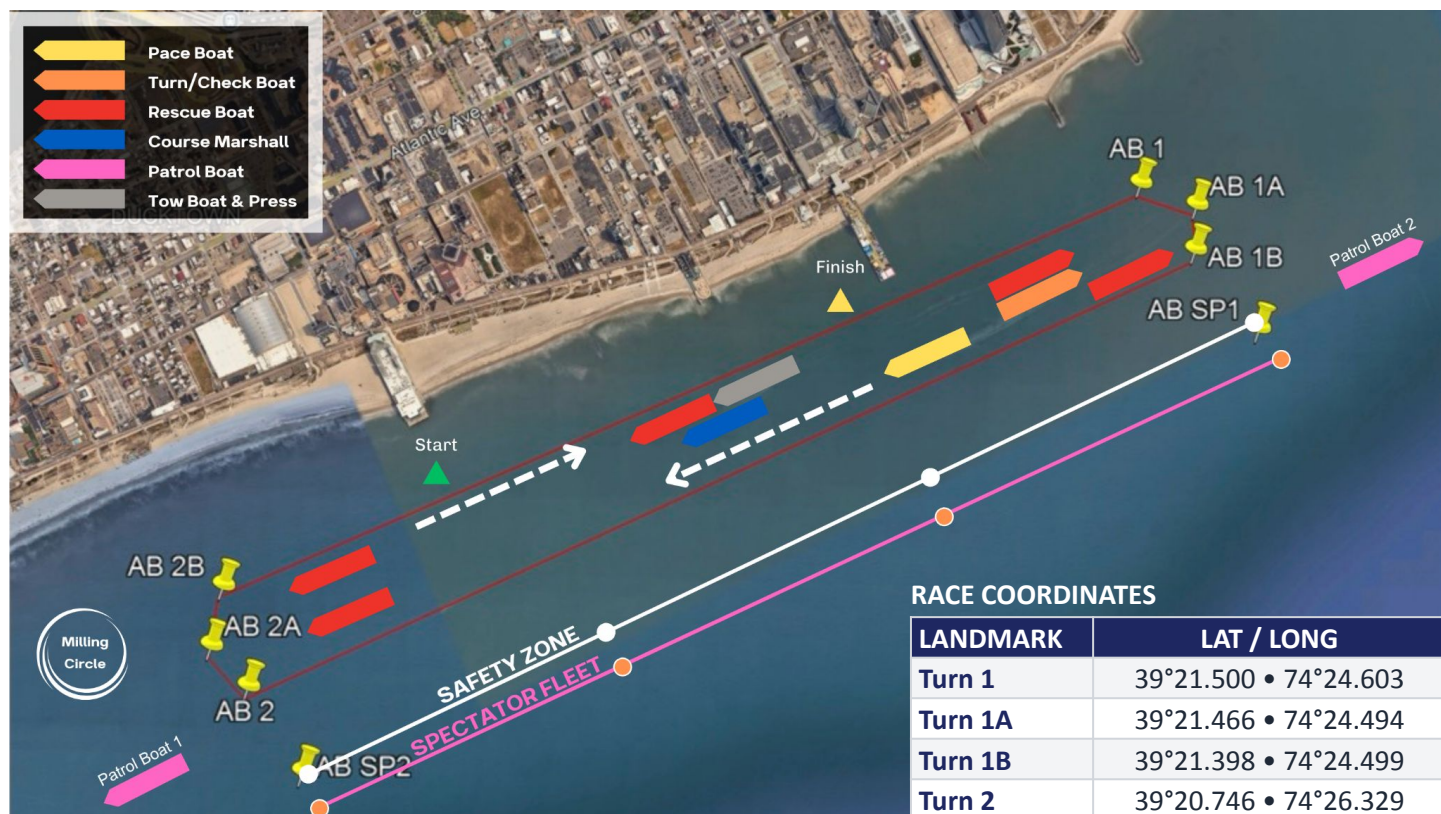
RACE COURSE & SUPPORT BOATS

ATLANTIC CITY RACE COURSE

The RWO Offshore race course is a clockwise course with a total distance of approximately 5.0 miles. The start line is about 1 mile from the finish line and race teams will mill to the northeast of turn 1 in preparation for race starts.

SUPPORT BOATS

TOW BOATS

Tow boats assist if a boat becomes disabled or broken down and takes them to safe place on the race course.

RESCUE BOAT

Boats identified as rescue boats are staffed with RWO trained divers and medical staff to assist in case of incident.

PACE BOAT

Pace boat brings boats from inner basin to milling circle and they are responsible for starting various heats.

PATROL BOAT

These boats manage a specific zone area to ensure spectators do not infringe on the race course.

COURSE MARSHAL BOATS

Two course marshal boats set and manage the race course.

TURN / CHECK BOAT

Boats in each turn are a visual landmark for turns and have staff event scorers.
