# #1 Establishing Shot



**This extreme long shot establishes the setting, a high school classroom and introduces the subject of the next shot (backpack).**

## #2 Extreme Long Shot



**This shot clearly has the subject as the main focus and shows the main character of the story for the first time.**

## #3 High Angle



**A high angle was chosen for this shot to emphasize the situation that the main character is in. The framing shows that he is powerless and stuck.**

## #4 Long Shot



**This long shot was made to show the full action happening in the frame. In this case, it shows the subject jumping out of the backpack.**

## #5 Low Angle



**The low angle shows that the main character feels free and powerful after getting out of the bag.**

## #6 Extreme Long Shot



**This extreme long shot is used to show how small he truly is compared to the other objects in the class.**

## #7 Medium Shot



**This medium shot shows the subject realizing how small he is and his reaction. It also shows the background and how close to the floor he is.**



## #8 Close-Up



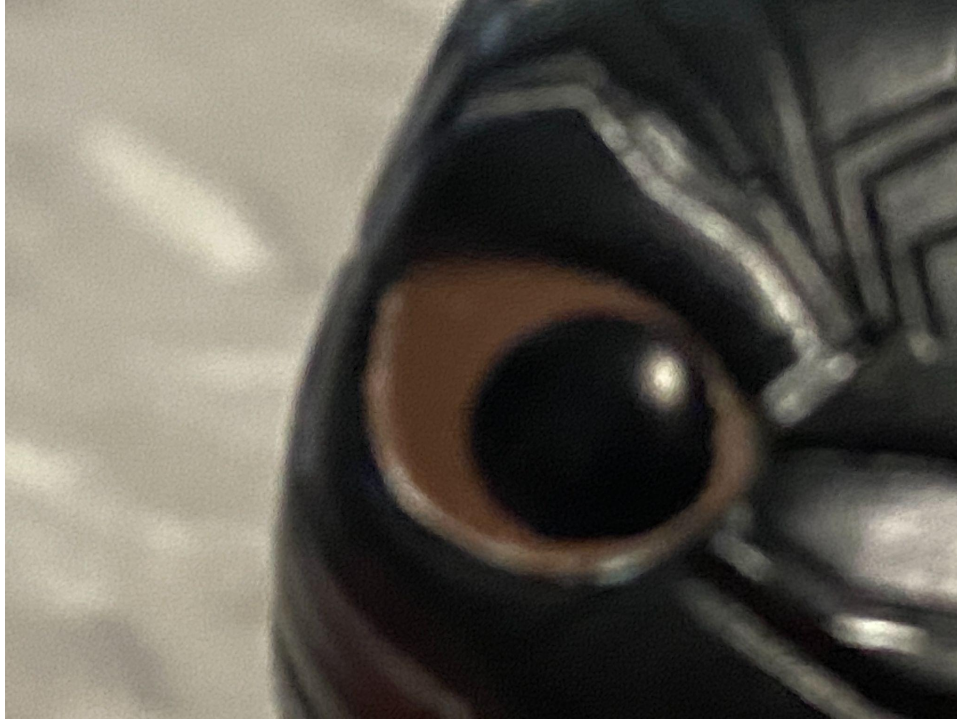
**The close-up highlights the expression on the subject's face. It could mean that something bad will happen soon that the audience doesn't know about.**

## #10 Extreme Close Up



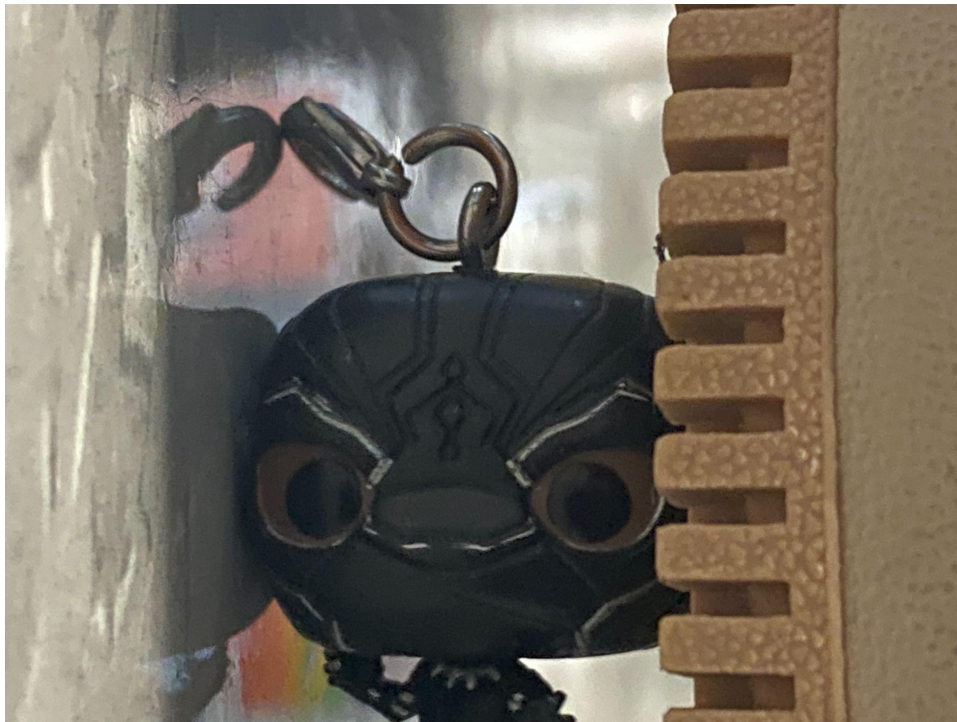
**Again, this shot exaggerates the fear the subject feels by zooming in directly to the eye.**

## #11 Long Shot



**The long shot shows the subject's full body and everything that is happening to him.**

## #12 Close-Up



The close-up shows his emotions after being stepped on; the main focus is his face.

## #13 Long Shot



**The long shot not only shows what is happening to the subject, but also shows the hand that picks up the subject. This is so the viewer understands why he is in the air.**

## #14 Medium Shot



**This medium shot shows the subject and the background. The viewer sees the water bottle and backpack from the beginning of the video and understands he was put back.**

## #15 Extreme Long Shot



**The extreme long shot officially shows he is back in the backpack and is completely back to where he was in the beginning.**
