

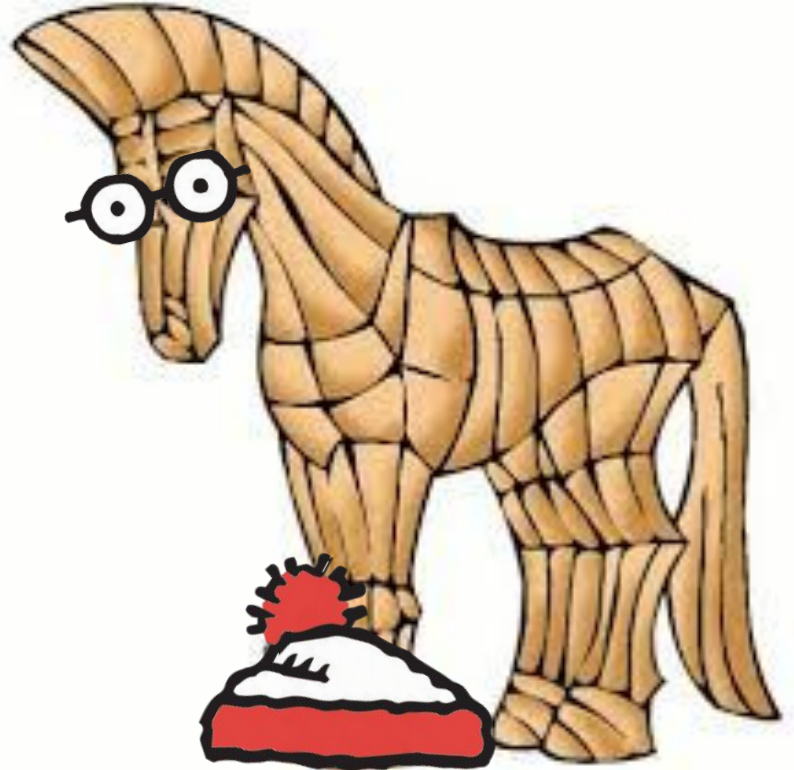


Where's Odysseus?

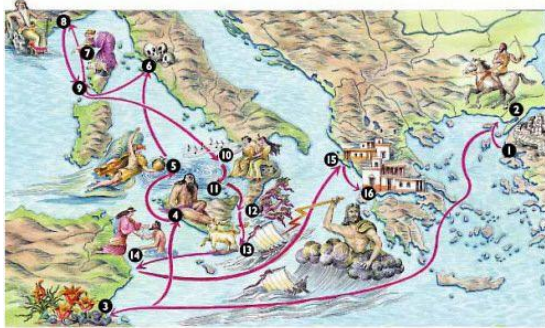
First Step

1. Open a [new map](#)
2. Add the following layers to your map
 - The Hero's Journey
 - This will include all locations to which Odysseus and his crew traveled
 - Distance traveled
 - This layer should denote the order in which Odysseus and his crew traveled to each location

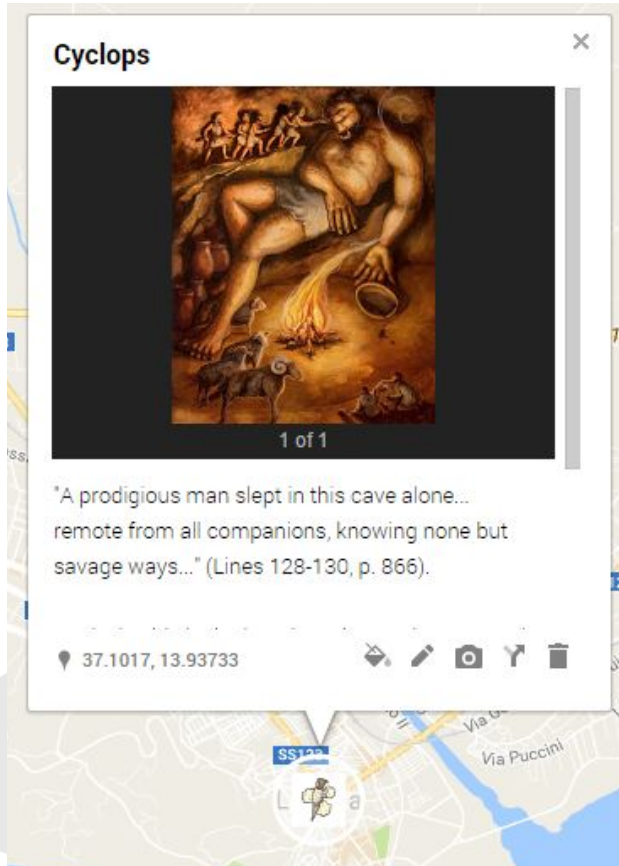
Location, location, location!

- One **image** that fits Homer's description of the location/plot points

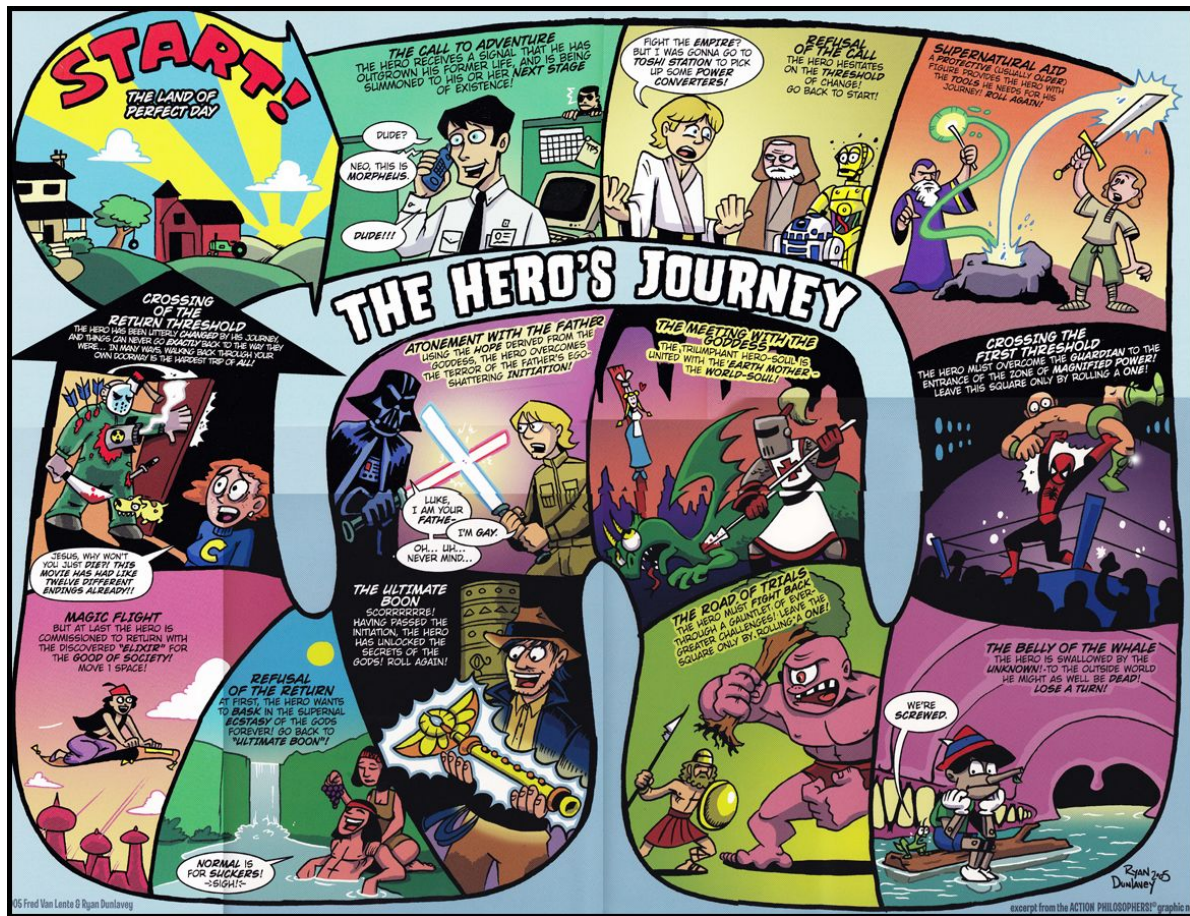
