Before you request transcripts or letters of recommendation!



- RCPS high schools use a program called Major Clarity for sending transcripts, letters of recommendation, and school reports to colleges.
- Be checking the "Rising Senior College Applicants Landing Page" regularly. We will be adding new information as we receive it.
- All transcripts and Letters of Recommendation must be sent through Major Clarity.
 Please do not email teachers asking them to send a letter of recommendation to a school.
 If you have a recommender that is outside of SHS, it is fine to ask them to send a letter of recommendation as you see fit.

We will hold a Rising Senior and a Major Clarity training in the first weeks of September!


Fall is time for Senior 1:1's.

Researching Colleges

- What Majors do they have?
- What is their stance on AP/DE courses?
- What about SAT/ACT scores?
- Cost and locations?
- Required High school Coursework
- What documents do they want?
- What scores do they expect?
 - AP exams / GPA / SAT or ACT
- What are their deadlines?
 - Early Action | Early Decision | Regular Admission | Rolling



The anatomy of a college application:

- Application fee (waivers may be available)
- Transcript
- School Profile
- Personal Statement/Essay
- Teacher/Counselor Recommendation
- SAT/ACT Test Scores, AP Scores (Counselors do not send these!)
- Mid-year and final transcripts

Why should I hold off sending my transcripts until September?

Transcripts are not typically available until Mid Sept. Why?

- 1. MajorClarity will not be active in the summer.
- 2. We need to get through schedule changes to be sure senior schedules are correct.
- 3. Senior schedule may not be added on transcript until school begins.
- 4. In August, counselors are:
 - a. Double checking for scheduling errors.
 - b. Adding new enrollments
 - c. Adding final grades from summer courses

All of these factors impact GPA and class rank!

Transcripts

- With the knowledge you have from the previous slide, you may still request an <u>unofficial</u> transcripts by emailing registrar, Debbie Correa, dcorrea@rockingham.k12.va.us
- Colleges will require an <u>official</u> transcript to be sent <u>directly</u> from SHS.
- Official transcripts should be requested through Major Clarity & <u>at least 2 weeks</u> <u>before deadline.</u>
- Please note: official transcripts will not be sent until closer to the school's deadline.
- Transcripts for scholarships can be requested by email registrar or school counselor.
- Mid Year Transcripts are sent automatically.
- Final Transcripts are sent <u>after</u> final grades are stored in PowerSchool which will be AFTER graduation. Counselors will send ONE final transcript to the school that the students indicates.

Letters of Reference

- <u>Teacher</u> LORs are requested through MajorClarity. (outside recommenders may be requested how you wish)
- Follow their rules: Does the college you are applying to actually want a recommendation letter?
 Do they have a limit (ex: no more than 1)?
- Be sure to ask someone who will write a *favorable* letter of recommendation.
- Give the writer at least 2-4 weeks to complete the letter.
- Don't forget teachers (and counselors!) have winter & summer break too!
- Include a resume or list of your activities & accomplishments so the recommender knows what to include!
- Always say THANK YOU with a note, email, or card.

- Check College Admissions pages to see if they are testing OR testing optional. Is
 your college test optional? Find out by clicking <u>HERE</u>. (We would still recommend
 that you check with each school for advisement and confirmation)
- If you qualify for Free or Reduced Lunches you may request testing Fee Waivers from your counselor.
- ASVAB used to determine qualification for enlistment in the United States Armed Forces.
 - Military based, Date: TBA STAY TUNED!

MajorClarity

- We will send; Transcripts, letters of recommendation, Common App Forms & SHS school profile.
- ALL college document requests MUST go through MajorClarity, even if you apply through Common App, directly to the institution, or Coalition.
- These requests can only be made by Student, not a parent.

Scholarships & Financial Aid

- The FAFSA can be filled out starting in October.
- Scholarships will be available in the Winter/early Spring
 - Keep checking in every so often new ones come out often!
 - Use pen, keep it neat, papers flat & organized!
 - Watch deadlines!
- Apply, apply, apply!! Even if they are only for a small amount.
- Be SMART Scholarship Scams DO EXIST
- Don't forget!
 - Financial Aid Help Sessions held in the fall during Advisory

Pro Tips for a HAPPY Application Season

We know watching your senior applying to college can be STRESSFUL on families.

- Have an organization tool. Here's an <u>EXAMPLE</u>.
- Have a resume or "brag sheet" handy (for letters of rec)
- Do NOT not wait until the last minute!
 - I repeat... do not wait until the last minute!
- Set healthy boundaries to manage stress and balance
- Celebrate milestones and make memories
- Attend any and all info sessions together: from admissions, college fairs, financial aid, etc

Parents:

put your senior in the driver's seat, but offer directions from the passenger side.
