FREE AND REDUCED-PRICE MEAL APPLICATIONS

Apply online NOW so that benefits will be in place when school starts!

Families who meet certain federal income standards are eligible for free or reduced-price meal benefits. All children use their MCPS ID number at the register so confidentiality is maintained and no child is overtly identified as receiving free or reduced-price meals. Only one application is needed for all students in a household. A new application must be completed for any family requesting assistance this school

- COVID-19 Vaccination Attestation
 Gradesheet will show 83.3% for successful completion)
- Fingerprinting/Background check (only if the volunteer is working alone with students without supervision of an MCPS staff member or other type of volunteer service, per the Volunteers Regulation and FAQ)

MCPS has created a step-by-step **User-Guide** (with pictures) on how volunteers can create and access their myMCPS Classroom/Canvas account to complete the Online Recognizing Child Abuse and Neglect Training module AND upload the *Certificate of COVID-19 Vaccination* from the state Department of Health.

Volunteers: Vaccinations & Exemptions



At this current time proof of vaccination MUST be submitted online through myMCPS classroom.

- Names on the approved list will only show if the volunteer has done <u>BOTH</u> the online Child Abuse and Neglect Training AND the vaccination attestation.
- If this expectation ever changes, school principals and volunteer liaisons will be immediately notified and the website and appropriate guidance documents will be updated to reflect any changes.

If there is a volunteer who has a medical or religious exemption, the volunteer can submit it to Mr. Khalid Walker via email at: Khalid_D_Walker@mcpsmd.org. He will address each submission as he does for MCPS staff.
