# Basic Mode

- **Language Communication**

- **A very good and efficient way of communication**
- **Including: verbal communication, writing communication, pictures or shapes**
- **Verbal Communication: face to face conversations, meetings, ect.**
- **Writing Communication: letters, mail, advertisements, emails**
- **Pictures: slideshows, PPT, movies, ect.**
- **Better at conveying information**

- **Body Language Communication**

- **Including: action, expression, and eyes**
  - **Voice plays an important part in body language; the tone you use and the volume you are in when you saying it, it's all part of the body language**
- **Better communication between people through thoughts and emotions**

# Process of Communication

- a. **Sender** : the person who delivering a message to recipient
- b. **Message** : referring to the message that the sender is relaying to the receiver
- c. **Channel of Communication** : method of delivering the message
- d. **Decoding** : interpretation of the message, mostly performed by the receiver
- e. **Receiver** : the person that is getting or receiving the message
- f. **Feedback** : if the receiver have a feedback or response to the sender, as well as the start of an interaction

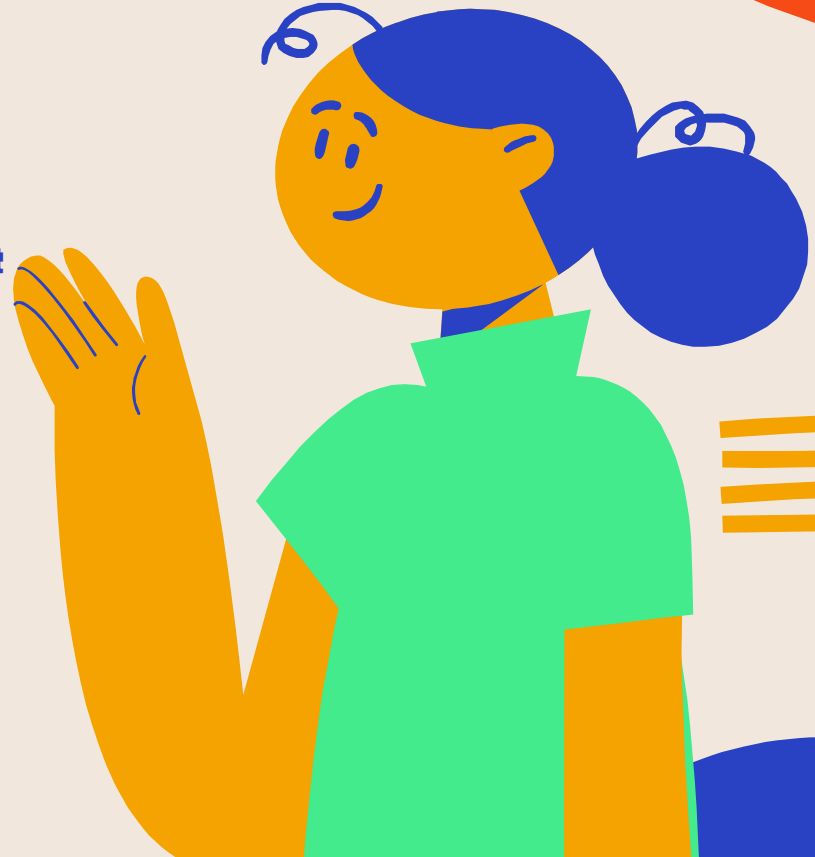
# WHAT IS COMMUNICATION?

Communication is the process of sending and receiving messages through verbal or nonverbal means.



# Tips on Communications

- **Speak Out: especially your thoughts, feelings, and emotions (tell receivers what you want or what you want them to know); no just complaining and attacking the whole time**
- **Respect each other**
- **Think before you speak, don't said thing you shouldn't say, will get worse**
- **Give responds and agree with each other**
- **Ask questions**
- **Use eye contact**
- **Use your face expressions and hands**
- **Use your voice**
- **Be a listener**
- **Be confident**
- **Effectively tell the receiver directly**
- **Make good use of inquire and listening skills**
- **Tell from a first person point of view**
