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Strategy : STOP and DERAIL

All Fossil Gas Applications and Prevent Lock-in

1.Stop and/or Delay the application and the Permitting Process and the Legislative Track of Fossil Gas Bills. [

1.7 GW of SMC application was stalled already since February 2021]

2.Developing the Site of Struggle [Batangas City]— organizing the resistance.

2.1. Reconvening of Piglas Batangas - movement vs Fossil Gas in Batangas City/Province [collaboration of 27 church/ orgs/individuals in Batangas City] Enforcement & Raising the Standards/ Key Biodiversity Areas/Verde Island Passage

2.2. PMC] Organizing and Campaigns Team to hasten the building of the Batangas City resistance.

2.3. Legal and Administrative Complaints Filing - EIS, Application Process

3. National BROAD FRONT : Reconvene Piglas Pilipinas as a national movement of many CSOs, environment groups, church, think tanks, etc vs. fossil gas expansion in the Philippines [Joint effort :24 Organizations Convened by APMDD] Piglas Pilipinas was reconvened last May 26, 2021

4. Challenge the Power Supply Agreement [1.8 GW of SMC]

5. Push for the planned phaseout of coal and fossil fuel plants and raise the standards - Peak use of coal and fossil fuel by 2030

6. Changing the Narrative — LNG into Fossil Gas
