Wiki Work

Need to organize your notes or various aspects of a semester-long project? To help you stay organized, create a wiki.

“A wiki is an online collaborative writing environment (some freely available online: PBWiki, Wikidot, Wikispaces) that gives students an opportunity to author, revise, and share course-related materials” (The Ohio State University, Center for the Study and Teaching of Writing, n.d., “Wiki work”).

You can use a wiki to collaborate or you can use it to revise and organize your course material (notes, assignments, instructor feedback).

This exercise will help you

- build technology skills
- learn the course material
- strengthen communication and organization skills

Tip: An e-portfolio is a great alternative; contact an ePortfolio assistant to learn how to create one.
